Electro Computer Days 2000 begins at BUET today

A three-day Electro Computer Days 2000 begins at the Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology (BUET) campus today.

Association of Computer and Electrical Students (ACES), an organisation of BUET students has organised the programme with a view to 'developing students' potentiality through learning of technological education.

The programme also aims to make the BUET a better educational institution for technological studies in the country, chief executives of ACES Muhammad Mostafa Hossain said while speaking a press conference at the Jatiya Press Club Tuesday.

The inaugural ceremony of the programme will be held at the BUET auditorium at 9 am which will be followed by an inter-school Application Software Contest at EME building at 11 am. Some 20 school will participate in the contest.

A nationwide computer programming contest will also be organised on the first day of the event in which some 33 teams from BUET, Khulna, Jahangirnagar, Chittagong and other

private universities will take part. Each team will be allowed four hours to solve six problems. There will also be another programme titled 'Demonstration Net Learning'.

An open discussion on 'Challenge and Opportunities of Mobile Telecommunication in Bangladesh' and a seminar on 'Computer Education and Training - Present Status and Future Need' will be the main attractions of the second day's.

Former chairman of BTB Fazlur Rahman will be the keynote speaker of the open discussion while president of BCS Abdullah H Kafi, president BISIC S M Kamal, executive director of BCC Prof Abdus Sobhan, Dr Alamgir Hossain of Dhaka University and Dr Chowdhury Mofizur Rahman and Dr Zamilur Rahman of BUET will be speakers at the seminar.

Other programmes on the second day include a web page design contest and inter institute quiz competition on IT and Electrical and Electronic Engineering. Some 30 teams will take part in the web page design contest.

Malaysian envoy makes farewell call on President

The outgoing Malaysian High Commissioner to Bangladesh Dato Zulkifly Bin Abdur Rahman made a farewell call on President Justice Shahabuddin Ahmed at Bangabhaban yesterday, reports UNB.

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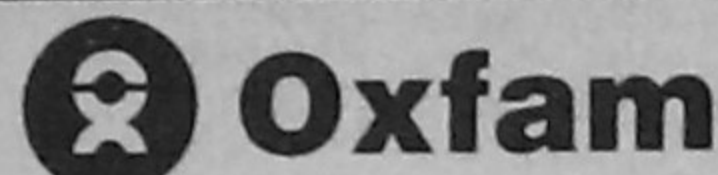

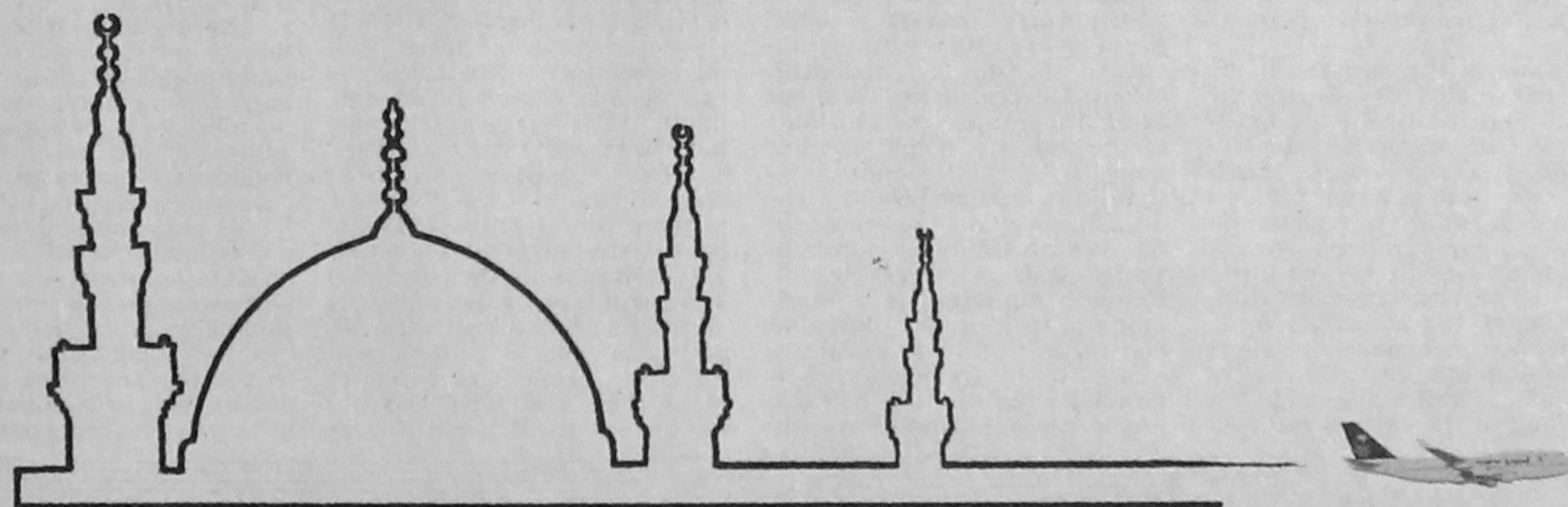
