

# Kushtia dairy farms face fodder crisis

KUSHTIA, June 17: Dairy farm owners in the district have been facing various problems including lack of proper marketing facilities and fodder crisis.

Some dairy farm owners said lack of marketing facilities is the main obstacle to the development of dairy farms. We cannot sell our product in the distant parts of the country due to lack of the facilities, they added.

Besides, dearth of essential drugs for the livestock and fodder crisis is also prevailing in the district, hampering the growth of the industry.

Veterinary hospitals situated in the district and upazila headquarters cannot provide adequate treatment facilities to livestock in remote areas, local people said.

Diseases such as khura, worm, ring worm and diarrhoea take a heavy toll on cattle every year, causing severe financial loss to farmers.

According to district Livestock Office source, there are 148 dairy farms in the district. Total number of milch cows in those farms is 1,305. An average 6,575 litres of milk are produced from those cattle daily whose market value is 65,750 taka.

**Our Sathkira correspondent adds:** Milk production has sharply fallen in the district. The number of milch cows has rapidly decreased in seven upazilas in the district in recent years.

The poor farmers engage their milch cows in cultivation, decreasing the milk production.

Besides, milch cows are being slaughtered in various parts of the district, causing decrease in number of milch cows.

Moreover, shortage of fodder has also been attributed to the decrease in the number of milch cows.

## Tushar wants to be a physician

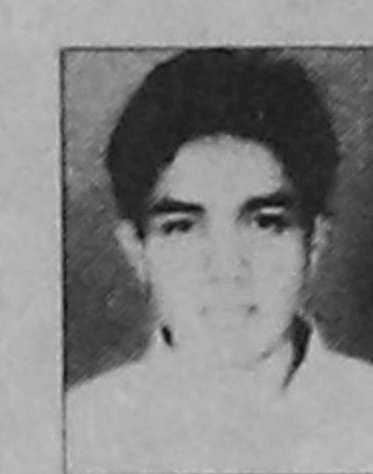

BANDARBAN, June 17: In an attempt to eradicate polio and tetanus, Health Department and Army jointly executed a unique immunisation programme in the hill district, marking the 7th National Immunisation Programme (NIP), reports UNB.

Under the programme, field workers of the Health Department went to inaccessible areas along Bangladesh-Myanmar border by army helicopters and fed polio vaccines to under-6 children. They also administered tetanus injections to 2,000 women of the 15-49 age group. The Health Department has so far vaccinated 50,000 children in seven thanas here. According to officials, illiterate women and children of 51 moujas of the frontier area would know little about immunisation before the 6th NIP. Until then, the health workers could not enter the detached land.

The budget was presented at a joint meeting of CU Syndicate and Finance Committee, chaired by Vice Chancellor Prof Abdul Mannan last week.

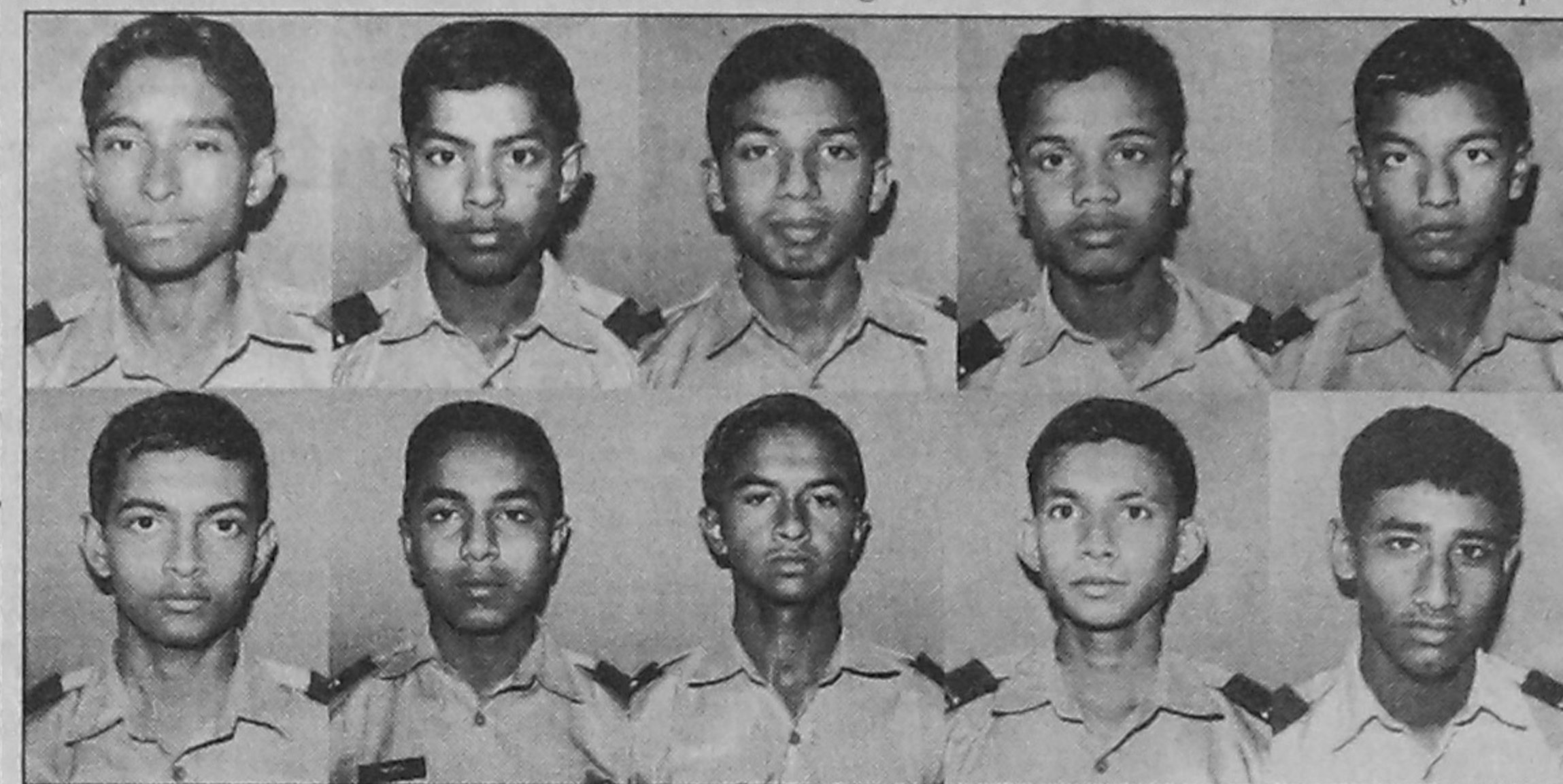
Controller of Accounts of the university Siddiqur Rahman Bhuiyan presented the budget. The revised budget of Tk 34 crore 41 lakh and 90 thousand with a deficit of Tk 81.90 lakh for 1999-2000 FY was also announced in the meeting.

In the budget of 2000-2001 FY, Tk 32 crore 45 lakh is expected to come from the government through the University Grant Commission (UGC), while Tk 1 crore 95 lakh is expected to come from the internal sources, leaving a deficit of Tk 82 lakh 35 thousand.

The revised budget for the fiscal 1999-2000 showed an amount of Tk 31 crore 50 lakh was received from the government through UGC and Tk 2 crore 10 lakh was collected from internal sources of the university, resulting in deficit of Tk 81 lakh 90 thousand.

While discussing the budget Prof Abdul Mannan said that the government had already approved a sanction of Tk 20 crore in the 5th five-year plan to create minimum facilities for students, teachers, officials and employees of the university.

At the primary stage of the project the government had allocated Tk 2 crore in the ADP for the next fiscal and with this money initiative will be taken to construct a residential hall for 500 students and a TSC cum Senate Building, he added.
