Praner Bandhu Sings Yesterday Once More

A 'Ferdousi' evening at Bengal Shilpalaya

One of the most popular Palli Geeti exponent, Ferdousi Rahman's, has just launched her CD on folk music (Palli Geeti), titled Praner Bandhure. The CD, launched at the Bengal Shilpalaya on Saturday, contains 14 selected songs including the title track. This is the first time her CD has been released

in the country. Her earlier CD

releases were the USA and

India. The initiative by the Bengal Shilpalaya deserves appreciation. They have recently launched two CDs. Of these, one is Farida Parveen's Shomoy Gele Shadhon Hobe Na. The CD was launched on the 7th of July. The other CD of which this article is all about is Ferdousi Rahman's Praner Bandhure. It was a simple yet delightful ceremony at the Bengal Foundation. The renowned artiste was there to present a few of her selected songs, some of which are from the new CD. Ferdousi was radiating with

an off-white Kaman with a deep green paar with zari work on it.

The programme started with the ceremonial launching of the CD by none other than renowned singer, bricist and composer Abdul Latif

- Ferdonsi's LaCha (Latif

Chacha). He was full of praise of Ferdousi whom he has known since her childhood. The association between them spans decades - Ferdousi has been singing Latif's compositions since 1952. Latif recalled his early entry into the world of music which made his aunt (Phuppi) furious till she heard that he performed Abbasuddin's (Ferdousi's father) compositions. Such was Abbasuddin's acceptance and reverence in society! Latif addressed Ferdousi as the princess of Bhawaiya.

In her short speech, Ferdousi Rahman was full praise Bengal Foundation's initiative. However she lamented the fact that the people have lost the chance to preserve the songs of some of the best singers of the bygone era. Songs of Laila Anjuman Banu, Hasna Banu Khanam,

Abdul Alim and many others will eventually fade out and be lost forever, she said. Her request to Bengal Foundation was therefore to record and release cassettes and CDs of performers who were in their prime time so as to be able to preserve their best output.

After the ceremonial launching, the audience were with a selected songs by Ferdousi. These included Koto ronger pireete tumi jano re bandhu (composed by Abdul Latif), the title track of her CD, and Neemer dotora (by her uncle Abdul Karim) Among the adhunik (modern) songs she presented was her famous romantic tune Ami sagorer o Neel (lyrics: Abu Hena Mustafa and Music: Abdul Ahad). She also sang ghazals, Nazrul Geetis and Abdul Alim hit Bhromora gaiyona goon goon. She rendered ten songs in all.

Alliance Française de Dhaka, Bibi Russell and Dr Abdullah, Technical Director of the Bangladesh Jute Research Institute, have made some attempts to add value to jute rugs by introducing the silk fibre blended with jute in traditional weaving techniques. Bibi Russell has identified saturanjis as the ideal and viable product to materialise this project. Samples of jute and silk sataranjis will be shown on the occasion of this exhibition.
