One attacked inside CMM Court

Mohammad Rafiqul Islam, an accused in a theft case was seriously injured when another accused in the same case attacked him in Dhaka Magistrate's Court yesterday.

The incident took place in the western side of the Chief Metropolitan Magistrate's Court yesterday at around 12 noon when Rafiq was going to his lawyer's chamber after appearing before the Court of Metropolitan Magistrate M Shamsur Rahman.

Mahmud Hossain, another accused in the same case along with his groups attacked Rafiq threatening him not to appear before the court again. Rafiq shouted for help and passersby rescued him.

The attackers fled the scene. The victim filed a general diary with Kotwali thana in this regard. Another petition was submitted before the court in connection with the attack but the court advised him to go to the thana instead.

Nat'l nutrition mapping plan should be taken: Matia

Agriculture Minister Matia Chowdhury yesterday laid emphasis on undertaking a national programme for proper mapping and implementation of nutrition related projects, reports BSS.

The minister said this while speaking as the chief guest at the inaugural session of the two-day workshop on "Food Insecurity and Vulnerability Information and Mapping System (FIVIMS)" organised by the Bangladesh Institute of Research and Training on Applied Nutrition (BIRTAN) at IDB Bhaban in the city.

Stressing the importance of specific information for identifying and locating vulnerable groups, she said a national programme of FIVIMS in Bangladesh would help in minimising information gap in planning, implementing monitoring and evaluating many of the nutrition interventions.

Referring to the various government's nutrition related projects, the minister said the nutrition programmes in some cases are yet to achieve desired result due to lack of coordination in nutrition programmes.

The minister said around 350 to 500 million people of the developing countries were at risk of malnutrition hampering economic growth and development.

Strike at IU to protest hike of tuition fees

JHENIDAH, July 12: The first day of a two-day hartal called by Chhatra Oikya backed by Bangladesh Chhatra Union, Chhatra Moltry, Chhatra Front, Biplabi Chhatra Moltry, JCD and Islami Chhatra Shibir went peacefully in the Islamic University (IU) today in protest of increasing tuition and other fees by the IU authorities, according to striking students organisations.

No classes or examinations were held today. Many students organisations brought out a rally and held meetings protesting the decision of IU authorities for increasing the fees.

The student leaders have threatened an indefinite strike unless the authorities withdraw the fee hike by tomorrow.

Professor Mohammad Kayesuddin, Vice-Chancellor of IU, has called an emergency meeting of all deans, proctors, student advisors and provosts of the halls today.

An 8-member committee has also been formed to negotiate with the student leaders. The committee will meet with the student leaders today to discuss how to resolve the crisis.

GCO launches signature campaign

GCO's other demands are immediate formation of an "acceptable" probe body to investigate the rape and killing incidents and measures to free the campus from firearms and terrorists.

To press home their demands, the GCO, a conglomerate of some left student fronts brought out a procession and held a rally on the campus yesterday. The rally was addressed by Nurul Islam, Monjur-e-Khoda Torik, Diponkar Shahi Dipu, Sabba Ali Khan and Imam Gazzali.

FOBANA to hold Bangladesh Convention September 1-3

Federation of Bangladesh Associations in North America (FOBANA) will hold a Bangladesh Convention in New York September 1-3, reports UNB.

The three-day convention will include a number of seminars on subjects having immediate or far reaching effects on Bangladeshis living in US and the people of Bangladesh, said Shelley a Mubdi, convenor of 14th FOBANA Bangladesh Annual Convention, at a press conference at Jatiya Press Club yesterday.

The convention will also be featured by cultural programme to be participated in by renowned artists like Runa Laila, Shafiq Ghosh, Farida Parveen and Selim Chowdhury as well as Bangladeshi artists living in USA.

Organisers said some 25 thousand people are expected to attend the convention.

BNP protests PM's remarks on political use of religion

BNP joint secretary general Abdullah Al Noman has strongly protested the Prime Minister's remarks that Awami League had never used the religion for political purposes.

In a statement yesterday, he said the AL nakedly used the religion in the past and continued using religion for petty party interest and also to score political mileage.

Noman said AL used the Islam during 1996 national elections and its leaders and activists used religious dress, chanted Islamic slogans and published posters where they used religion for political interest. Even Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina took part in election campaign wearing religious costumes, he added.

The BNP leaders said though AL frequently used Islam for petty political score but after assuming to power it hurt the religious sentiment of mass people. It imposed Section 144 around the Baitul Mukarram National Mosque, fired shots and tear gas shells, and resorted to lathi charge inside the mosque that left many devotees injured.

He said the AL government which conspired to close down the madrassahs, launched attack in religious functions and continued frequent attacks on religious sentiment of the people.

One killed in N'ganj over kabadi match

NARAYANGANJ, July 12: One person was killed by opponents in a 'kabadi' match in 'Araihazar' thana on Tuesday evening. He was identified Majibur Rahman, 30, son of Abdul Kader of village 'Khaliarchar' under the same thana.

Police said, Majibur was attacked with a spear in a clash over a 'kabadi' match in 'Khaliarchar' primary school playground by an opponent in the match. He died on the spot. His body was sent to Narayanganj General Hospital morgue for autopsy.

A case was filed with Araihazar thana. Police are yet to arrest anyone.
