A Tale of Modern-day Slaves

A depiction of the plight of Bangladeshi workers in Malaysia

YEASMIN Kabir organised the premiere show of her video documentary *Probashi Mon Amar* (My Migrant Soul) in association with Goethe Institut, Dhaka on July 11. The documentary deals with the tragedy of a Bangladeshi migrant worker at a detention camp in Kuala Lumpur in 1995.

The 30-minute film is the story of one Shahjahan Babu to provide documentary evidence to the stories of thousand others that have become victim to manipulation and have suffered exploitation at the hands of the unscrupulous manpower-exporting agents. The documentary was supplemented with interviews of Babu's mother and other family members, letters from Babu to his mother and audiotaped narrative of Babu's voice. Kabir, the maker and producer, used these supplementary materials to make it authentic. The audiotaped narrative of the protagonist throughout the show helps to reveal his dreams, expectations and discrimination while away from his own country.

Shahjahan Babu, having been lured, left for Malaysia in search of work like many other Bangladeshi migrant workers. The young dreamer became disillusioned the moment he arrived in the host country.

The documentary amply focused on perilous ventures and harsh realities that the unemployed young folks undergo both at home and abroad. It follows the protagonist to recount his venture posthumously. Scene of Babu's tragic story are set against the background that consists of factories, activities of the workers, construction sites, tourist spots, and the place where he used to live in Malaysia.

The documentary depicts how Babu met a deceitful manpower-exporting agent, his dreams and desires, the process of leaving the country, and later on, his family's helpless interaction with the agent.

Babu arrived in Malaysia only to find out that he was led to — his status being reduced to that of illegal immigrant. The film makes a poignant exposure of ruthlessness that Babu suffered at the hands of his employer in Malaysia. He was not given any permanent job. He was ill paid and deprived of his legal papers. He could only subsist with meagre pay let alone sending money for his family back home. He was denied all of human rights. Disappointments and fear haunted him all along. He had to remain abdicating from place to place

and from time to time in constant fear of Malaysian police, as he did not have legal papers.

As the documentary shows, Babu devoted utmost effort to overcome poverty. But everything went wrong and consequently everything ruined. Having been dismayed, he looked for a way out only to find no exit but a tragic end of his life. Babu's voice, subdued by unscrupulous mechanism, was faint but quite stirring. His helpless soul is contrasted against the magnificence of the sky-kissing concrete jungle. In the picture, the cry of Babu's imprisoned soul echoes on the Twin Tower.

Virtually fallen prey to deception, Babu was eventually arrested and put in a detention camp in Kuala Lumpur like many others. He was subjected to inhuman torture and all sorts of maltreatment there and consequently he became physically sick. Babu succumbed to torture and illness at the detention camp.

The screening was followed by a panel discussion moderated by Motiur Rahman, editor of the *Prothom Alo*. Three deported migrant workers — Gollam Mowla, Maran Majumdar and Sheikh Nasir Ahmed who had been detained for different

duration at the detention camp, took part in discussion to give eye witness to the brutal torture, humiliation and dehumanisation they had to undergo. They gave lurid details of their sufferings at the detention camp. This shocked the audience and left them almost speechless.

Gollam Mowla said that he had to sell off his loom and wife's ornaments to go to Malaysia. Maran Majumdar went into details in his reproduction of his 21-month-long bitterness. He underwent 110 days of imprisonment and was a detainee in Block-D of the camp. According to him the detainees were given inedible food, proper only for poultry feed. There was no arrangement of latrines in the camps. They were compelled to perform many abominable things.

Sheikh Nasir Ahmed spoke about different stages of a migrant's being illegal. Both legal and illegal migrants are to lead an abiding and confined life there.

Immigrants face frequent harassment in the hands of Malaysian police, and often the police personnel take away legal migrant's papers as such making them illegal.

While recounting, all three deportees tended to accuse the

As Real As Life

Charukala students prove that art is life

An exhibition has been going on in a ground-floor room, right next to the Zainul Gallery, of Dhaka Charukala Institute. The rather small size of art papers depicts a variety of scenes ranging from village houses, flowing rivers, flowers, people and nature. But the pictures, that are temporarily dominating the walls of the classroom of the Fine Arts Institute of Dhaka University, look as real as life itself.

These paintings are very special. The students of Charukala have put up their pieces at this open and informal exhibition display area from different experimental art-sessions at the institute and they are selling these for a cause.

They are braving to save a life — a child. The baby is the firstborn of Charukala Institute students' Maruf Ibne Said and Umme Asma Bithi. Their son

Ibne Maruf was born in January this year with a major defect in his heart. The physician has said that the only way to save the child is to have an operation performed on his heart and separate the lower chamber into two. This kind of an operation can only be performed in India which cost the patient about Taka 5 lakhs. The young couple, yet to complete their studies, can hardly afford this amount of money. However, they had true friends — the students of the Institute — who stepped in at the right time. They came forward to collect money that would require for the baby's treatment.

Since then, the relentless efforts at the ground-floor room of the institute have attracted the attention of all. They are working hard and putting their work on display. The cost of each piece of art on display is Taka 100. Their calculation is simple and clear: if 5000 paintings can be sold then the amount earned from the sale

will be Tk 5,00,000 which is enough for the basic cost of the operation for Maruf.

They have not stopped there. They have already lined up activities to raise more fund. They are holding an exhibition of paintings at the Zainul Gallery from July 15 to July 22, followed by cultural activities at Bangladesh Shilpa Academy. Art usually is all about life, and it has never been so realistic than this time. The paintings that were sold this whole week were created out of love and affection of the students of the institute for a fellow human. Each painting on display came to life with that inner message.

The bunch of flowers, for example, painted on a white sheet of paper is not ordinary but seemed to reach out to anyone passing it by. People who stopped to have a good look at it, have seen that this painting was talking, and it said... "help save a life, please".

Art is, indeed, life.

They also opined that government's policy in this regard "fell far short". The audience, too, were found aggrieved with our "inadequate" role in connection with saving Bangladeshi workers in Malaysia.
