BRAHMANBARIA, July 18: President of Jatiya Mohila Sangstha Ivy Rahman yesterday described the Jamaat-Shibir as human killers and urged the government to immediately ban the politics of religious fanatics.

From page 1 Basic treatment? The major abnormality observed in Dengue Haemorrhagic Fever (DHF) is increased loss of blood and of plasma from body.

orally and an antipyretic drug may be all that is needed. Sali-cylates should be avoided.

It is not necessary to hospitalise all patients with suspected DHF, since shock may develop in only about one-third of the patients.

Blood transfusions are indicated for patients with significant clinical bleeding. It may be difficult to recognise internal bleeding in the presence of haemoconcentration.
