## Two panels to contest JU senate polls

Two panels will contest the Jahangirnagar University (JU) Senate and Deans' polls scheduled for August 5.

The polls will be held to elect deans of 3 faculties and 33 teachers' representatives to the Senate.

Some pro-Awami League teachers have reached an alliance with a section of pro-BNP teachers while others will jointly form another panel for the polls of Deans of Science, Social Science and Arts Faculty, and representatives to the Senate, JU teachers said.

Pro-BNP teachers of the university led by Prof. Abu Sayeed Khan and Prof. M. Imamuddin and pro-AL teachers led by VC Prof. Abdul Bayes are likely to announce a joint-panel soon to contest the polls, sources said.

Meanwhile, pro-AL teachers led by Treasurer Prof. Shariff Enamul Kabir along with pro-BNP teachers led by Prof. Khondoker Mustahidur Rahman are also likely to announce their panel soon.

Sources seeking anonymity said that the conglomeration of

pro-BNP teachers led by Abu Sayeed Khan and pro-AL teachers led by VC Prof. Abdul Bayes have decided to nominate Prof. Abu Sayeed Khan (Physics) to contest for the post of Dean of Science Faculty, Prof. Shubhash Chandra Das (Geography and Environment) for Social Science Faculty, and Prof. M. Nasrullah (History) for Arts Faculty, the sources added.

The other alliance are likely to nominate Prof. Nurul Alam (Physics) to contest for Dean of Science Faculty, Prof. Mirza Mofizuddin (Geography and Environment) for Social Science Faculty, and Prof. M. Nasrullah (History) for Arts Faculty, the sources added.

Both the conglomeration will also announce two different panels within a few days time for the 33 teachers' quota to the Senate, sources said.

Both groups have already held several meetings on the campus and outside of it, and are expected to begin their campaign among the teachers soon, they said.

## Mayor Hanif seeks cooperation

Dhaka City Mayor Mohammad Hanif yesterday sought cooperation of the city dwellers to make the mosquito control drive, launched in the city to stem the spread of dengue fever, successful, reports BSS.

"Do not throw garbage everywhere, and remove stagnant water gathering in a variety of pots including flower tubs, broken bottles, polythene bags and abandoned drums," he urged the townspeople in a statement.

As several cases of dengue fever were detected in the city, Dhaka City Corporation (DCC) launched the drive to erase mosquitoes, especially of the Aedes varieties that carry dengue germs, by fogging and spraying larvicides in the city areas.

A total of 1000 field workers under the Department of Health of the DCC are carrying out the drive which was launched at the instruction of the mayor recently.

Hanif also called upon the city people to help the field workers in spraying insecti-

cides in their localities.

Meanwhile, a high-level meeting on gearing up mosquito control drive was held today at the Nagar Bhaban with DCC Secretary M. Habibullah in the chair.

Ward commissioners Kamal Chowdhury, Humayun Kabir, Chief Health Officer Dr. Ashrafuddin and other senior officials were present.

## 11 arrested with arms in city

Detectives and thana police seized three pistols, a cut rifle and a shutter gun and arrested eleven people during different raids in the city yesterday.

A Pallabi thana police team led by officer-in-charge Sirajul Islam yesterday arrested two people Badal Roy and Delwar Hossain Biddut and recovered a shutter gun from their possession from Muktiyoddha Complex Gate in the city.

Separate cases were filed with concerned police stations.

### Lawyers resent attempt to amend Hindu laws

Lawyers belonging to the Hindu community have expressed their resentment at the attempt to amend the existing Hindu laws, reports BSS.

The lawyers from the High Court and the Dhaka Court held a meeting under the banner of Hindu Law Amendment Resistance Committee at Dhaka Bar Association auditorium on Friday and described the attempt as a "conspiracy against the religion and culture."

They said the main problems facing the members of the Hindu community today are Enemy (Vested) Property Act, the 5th and 8th amendments to the Constitution and destruction of a number of temples including Ramna Kali Bari.

Presided over by the president of the resistance committee, Adv. Jagadish Chandra Sarkar, the meeting was attended by Prof. Dr. Lalit Mohan Nath as chief guest.

Among others, general secretary of Bangladesh Puja Udd-japan Parishad Kajol Devnath, president of ISCON Krishna Kirtan Das, Adv. Sushanta Kumar Basu, Adv. Jhulan Paul and Adv. Kishore Ranjan Mondal spoke on the occasion.

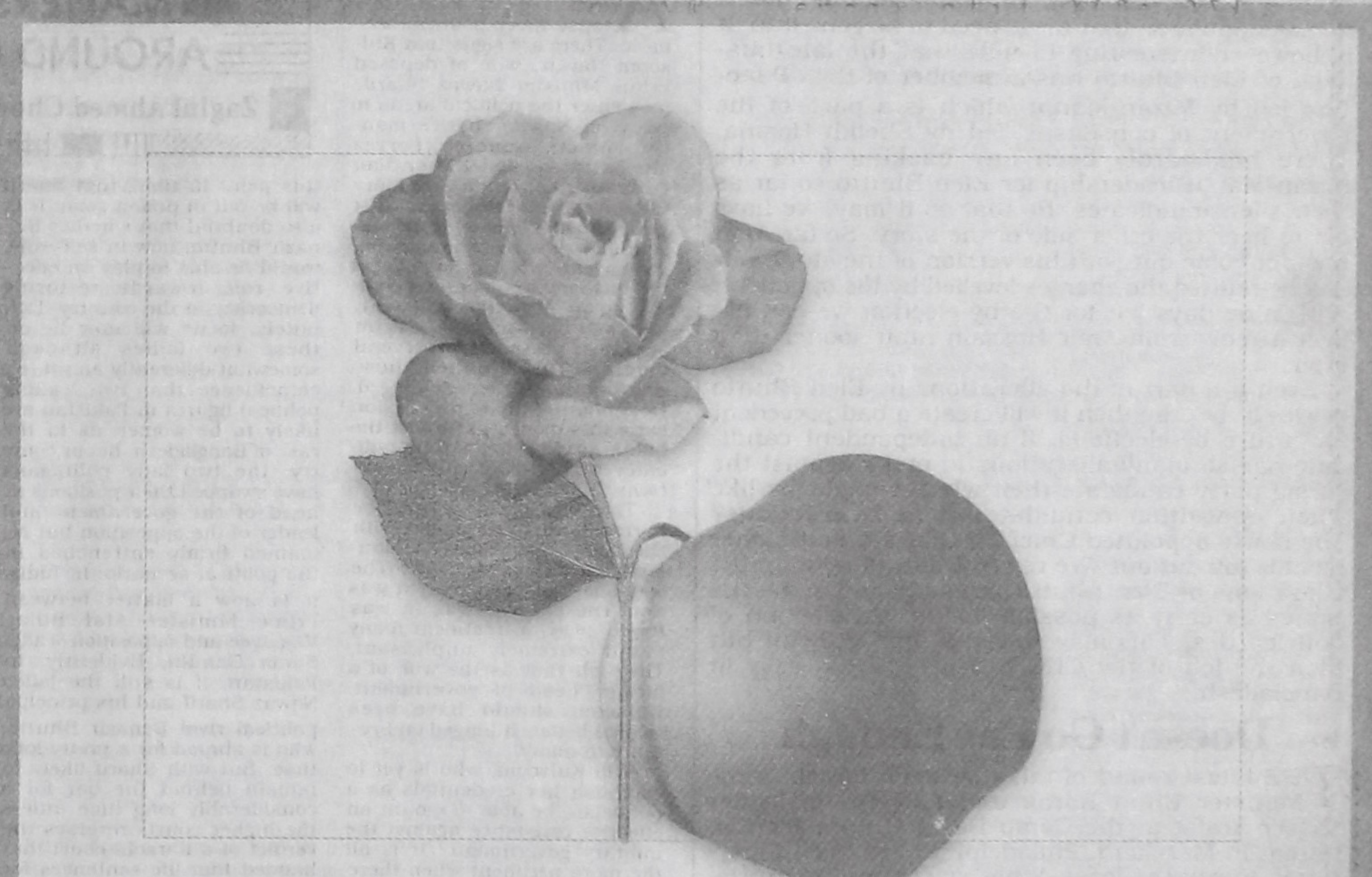
