

JP (M-M) condemns

Jatiya Party (M-M) chairman Mizanur Rahman Chowdhury has condemned the nefarious attempt on Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina's life by planting a bomb at Kotallipara.

"As a peace-loving liberal democrat, I strongly condemn this heinous attempt on the life of the head of the government," he said in a statement to UNB.

Chowdhury posed a question whether there was any fool-proof security checkup at Tungipara and Kotallipara before and after the Prime Minister's arrival there.

He said security of the Prime Minister does not mean that security men would only accompany her without ensuring her security in advance.

The JP leader also expressed concern over the recovery of another powerful bomb at Kotallipara helipad during the Home Minister's visit.

Chowdhury condemned the killing of eight people in Chittagong and journalist Shamsur Rahman in Jessore.

## Corrigendum

Shamshad Ahsan, area manager of the Qatar Airways in Bangladesh, in a corrigendum to a Daily Star report on fire on engine of its Airbus published on July 23, yesterday said there was no fire on the engines of the aircraft. There was some smoke in the no 1 engine which was detected by the Captain just after take off. It returned safely and after running a check the aircraft left Dhaka International Airport. The smoke was due to the spill of fuel over the top of the engine while the aircraft got refueled on the ground, he said, says a press release.

## Zillur's observation

Four-party  
alliance  
plotting to  
kill Hasina

Awami League General Secretary and Local Government Minister Zillur Rahman yesterday said the four-party opposition alliance was hatching conspiracy to kill Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina, reports BSS.

"As part of their conspiracy they planted a high explosive device at Kotallipara to kill Sheikh Hasina," he said addressing a rally here organised by Awami Jubo League to protest the bid to assassinate the prime minister.

He said: "We have not directly blamed the alliance for the attempt on the life of the prime minister. They are not condemning the incident. Why

they are telling that it was a set game of Awami League?"

Does not it mean that they were in fact involved in the plot? he asked.

Referring to the statement of opposition leader Begum Khalesa Zia that she wanted a repetition of 1975, Zillur Rahman said her open remark also proved that Begum Zia was involved in the plot to assassinate Sheikh Hasina.

"BNP has chosen the path of conspiracy as they think that the Awami League government could not be defeated through election," the local government minister said, adding that the BNP leaders made the same remark on a number of occasions.
