Project on population to be launched soon

Partners in Population and Development, a South-South initiative, will soon launch its third project titled "Support to Muslim Religious Leaders for Promotion of Reproductive Health and Family Planning among the Muslim Communities of the Partners' Countries" in view of considerable progress achieved in the population sector in Bangladesh and most of the developing countries, respectively.

Officials of the Partners' Secretariat in Dhaka told yesterday that leading population experts from at least seven member countries would meet next week in the Bangladesh capital to launch a new global approach in the field of reproductive health. The new approach is "The South-South Initiative: Alternative approach to sustained improvement in reproductive health." European Commission and the United Kingdom's Department of International Development (DFID) will support the initiative.

Dr Josephine Moyo, a senior programme adviser and project director of the Partners, about the South-South initiative said the five projects were devised to work with eight agencies to develop the capacity of 20 implementing organisations who would deliver and sustain the reproductive health activities among the member countries including Bangladesh.

With this new global initiative, the partners in collaboration with the concerned agencies will undertake five reproductive health projects to im-

prove reproductive health of men and women as well as to serve as the alternative model for development cooperation in the health sector.

Talking to BSS, the Partners' Executive Director Balla Musa Silla said, "The concept of South-South collaboration is deceptively simple and some developing countries have proven track record of meeting the reproductive health needs of men and women but there is still much to do to ensure that men and women will be able to enjoy good reproductive health."
