

Two bodies recovered in city

Police recovered bodies of two unidentified people, including a young woman, from different places in the city yesterday.

The body of the woman wrapped in a sack was recovered from a ticket counter at Gabtali bus terminal. The victim aged about 22 was strangled, police said.

According to witnesses, two young men riding an auto-rickshaw came in front of Shaikhin ticket counter. They disappeared soon after unloading the sack.

Mirpur police recovered the body at about 12 noon. There were several marks of injury in different parts of her body. The body was sent to the Dhaka Medical College Hospital for autopsy.

Meanwhile, Kafur police recovered the body of an old man from Kafur area in the morning. The body was found lying under a culvert on the east side of West Kafur Mukti Housing in the city.

A national seminar will be organised on August 7 at IDB Bhaban on "Rethinking Constitutional Politics: A Reform Agenda" by Governance Coalition (GC), reports UNB.
