

Sources in agriculture ministry said an inter-ministerial meeting was necessary to take a decision to allow aerial spraying. "We have to consider effects of the insecticides on humans and plants, and also their effectiveness and dose. This needs at least one week", an official of the ministry said.

Sources in the Department of environment (DoE) said there is no health risk in aerial spraying, which is highly effective in killing mosquito but not very effective on larvae.
