## Newspaper men to observe 'demand day' on August 7

Journalists, newspaper employees and press workers will observe 'Demand Day' on August 7 to protest the killing of Shamsur Rahman, Special Correspondent of The Janakantha based in Jessore, reports BSS.

The decision was taken yesterday at a meeting of the editors of national newspapers and news agencies, Bangladesh Federal Union of Journalists (BFUJ), Dhaka Union of Journalists (DUJ), Bangladesh Sangbadpatri Press Samikha Federation and Bangladesh Sangbadpatri Karmachari Federation at VIP lounge of the Jatiya Press Club with Amanullah Kabir in the chair.

The meeting demanded immediate arrest of the killers of Shamsur Rahman and security of the newspapermen. A rally will be held at 11 am at the Jatiya Press Club on the day. Members of Bangladesh Sangbadpatri Parishad (BSP), editors, journalists, press workers and general employees will attend the rally.

The meeting decided to form a joint committee with representation from BSP, editors, journalist unions and press workers and employees to solve various problems of the newspaper industry including security of newspapermen.

## Int'l seminar on reproductive health begins

# Over 5 lakh women die of pregnancy related complications each year

An international seminar marking the launching ceremony of Partners' global project on 'South-South Initiatives: An alternative approach to sustained improvements in reproductive health' began in the capital yesterday, reports BSS.

State Minister for Health and Family Welfare Prof Dr M Amanullah inaugurated the seminar as the chief guest.

Speakers from EC, DFID and Ministry of Health and Family Welfare spoke on the occasion.

Sixty-four participants from 16 countries involved in the implementation of the project attended the inaugural ceremony. The countries are Bangladesh, China, Colombia, Egypt, Gambia, India, Indonesia, Kenya, Mali, Mexico, Morocco, Pakistan, Thailand, Tunisia, Uganda and Zimbabwe.

Head of Population and Family Planning Sector of Egypt Dr Moushira Es-Shafel presided over the inaugural session.

State Minister for Health Prof Dr M Amanullah urged the development partners and donor agencies to work with coordinated efforts for the development of reproductive health with a view to curbing the mortality rates of mother and children.

He mentioned that over the last 20 years, developing countries have made significant progress in reducing fertility and population growth rates. However, reproductive health concerns continue to effect the lives of million.

In the developing world, 5.85 million women die each year

because of pregnancy-related complications and 333 million new cases of sexually transmitted infection are reported annually.

Prof Amanullah emphasized the need for increasing resources to address these issues. Political will and managerial ability including technical skill are urgently needed for

successful implementation of such issues, the state minister added.

Executive Director of Partners Balla Musa Silla, Programme Manager of Partners Secretariat Dr Gosephine Moyo, Senior Advisor of DFID Frank Artherton and Charge d'Affaires of European Commission (EC) Ketelsen also spoke.

## Husband arrested

NARAYANGANJ, Aug 2: Narayanganj thana police arrested Maksudul Islam alias Khokon, the alleged killer and husband of housewife Roksana Akhter from village Rangamalia under Sirajdikhan thana of Munshiganj district on Wednesday morning.

Khokon was absconding for last 6 months after killing his wife.

Acting on a tip-off a joint team of Narayanganj and Sirajdikhan thana police arrested Khokon from his grandmother's house in Rangamalia in the early hours of Wednesday. Housewife Roksana Akhter, 32, was shot dead allegedly by her husband in her bedroom on February 16 in BB Road.

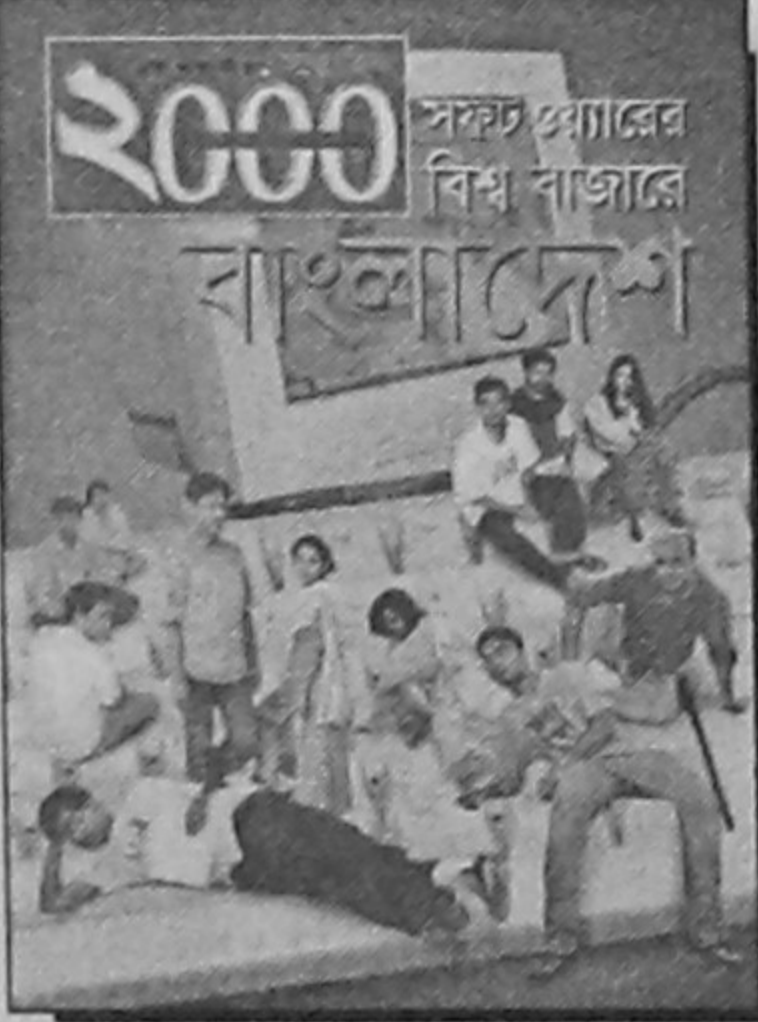
