IT Skills in New Millennium : Case Study of USA

WELCOME to the world of information technology. Computers, Software, the Internet, Wireless ... all these things are changing society, transforming the nature of work and exerting a powerful influence on the global economy. So, there are many good reasons to discuss about the career in information technology industry in recent times. Employers have created a demand for roughly 1.6 million IT workers in 2000 in USA only. Half of the demand will go unfilled. In a total US workforce of 10 million, this shortfall means that one job in every dozen will be vacant.

The table shows the difference between demand and supply for the eight categories.

A study of the Information Technology Association of America (ITAA) explains how dramatically changed the composition of the US workforce by producing an unimaginable demand for IT workers. The study offers findings in four major areas:

(1) The overall size of the IT workforce, the demand for qualified workers and the gap between supply and demand

(2) The hottest, most in demand jobs

(3) The skills workers need to grab one of these skills

(4) The best ways for workers to acquire these skills

The overall size of the IT workforce, the demand for qualified workers and the gap between supply and demand.

The 10 million strong workforce of IT workers is far larger than one might expect. The number does not include jobs in government, non-profit organizations or small entrepreneurial firms. It provides evidence of a sea change in the nature of work and emphasizes that the Internet and IT have become the twin pistons of the national economy of USA.

The demand for IT workers is large and growing. Employers will attempt to fill 1.6 million new IT jobs in 2000.

The demand of IT workers is widespread with interesting variations by geographic region. The south has the largest number of IT workers overall. The Midwest has the largest demand for IT jobs — 35% of the

total. The western region is second largest with 28% of the total demand.

The greatest need for IT workers is in the largest segment of economy — smaller non IT firms. Companies with 50-99 employees need one million IT workers next year (2001) or 70% of the total demand for all new IT employees. This group also has the highest skills gap; managers from these firms reported the highest rate of unqualified applicants and the greatest difficulty in filling positions.

While non-IT companies have more aggregate demand, the average IT company has far more jobs to fill — five times as many jobs for tech support representatives, six times as many for web developers, 12 times as many for database developers.

The hottest, most in demand jobs

Technical support jobs are in demand by both IT and non-IT companies alike (one third of all new positions by April 2001), required skills ranked highest for technical support jobs by managers were 1) Troubleshooting (97%); 2) Facilitation/customer support service
