

Hey y'all...I'm sorta back at assembly again...but 32bit this time...with the modern assemblers, it's almost as simple as high level API programming (not that that itself is a piece of cake...)...but writing a windows application in assembly is a whole LOT simpler than I first thought. Don't believe me? Check out Icelion's cool tutorials at <http://win32asm.cjb.net/>

When you're convinced, get what's probably the best assembler, Hutch's MASM32 (this isn't just a newer version of Microsoft's MASM, it's much more - it actually lets you avoid all that insanity over trying to make decisions using jumps, and lets you concentrate on the program. But the shortcuts it lets you use don't bloat your code in the way that using a high level language would.

In fact, your code size won't increase by even a single byte! You can actually write a program that displays a window without having to write a single line of code yourself, the exe file is just 2.5kb, and completely standalone (well, it needs win9x, nothing else). Compare that to an equivalent 20-80kb exe from VB or VC++ which needs several hundred kb of supporting DLLs. Anyway, you can read about and download MASM32 at www.pbj.com.au/home/hutch/masm.htm (4 megs, but really worth it if you wanna try Win32 assembly. You can also use it to write good old win16 and dos programs!
