Rainfall continues

More low-lying areas likely
to be inundated

More low-lying areas in and around Dhaka and Narayanganj are likely to be inundated as most places in Brahmaputra basin experienced light to moderate rainfall during last 24 hours till 9 am yesterday, reports UNB.

According to Flood Forecasting and Warning Centre, more areas between Bahadurabad and Aricha may also be inundated while the flood situation in Gohundo and Bhagyalul areas will further deteriorate.

The flood situation in Chapinawabganj district is likely to remain unchanged while the flashflood situations in greater Sylhet, Chittagong and Chittagong Hill Tracts are likely to improve.

The Brahmaputra-Jamuna marked further rise at all points except Noonkhawa while most of the rivers in Meghna basin recorded a fall and the rivers in Ganges and Southeastern Hill basins marked fall and rise respectively.

Out of 46 water level stations monitored by the centre, nine points remained above danger level, 21 points recorded rise, 19 points marked fall and one point remained steady during the period.

The Jamuna registered rise by 12 cm at Bahadurabad, 16 cm at Sirajganj and 25 cm at Aricha and it was flowing above red mark by 66 cm, 26 cm and

44 cm at the respective points. The Dharala rose by 60 cm at Kurigram and was flowing 22 cm above danger mark.

The Padma marked rise by 22 cm at Gohundo and 21 cm at Bhagyalul and it was flowing above red mark by 38 cm and 48 cm at the respective points.

The centre recorded highest rainfall of 54.2 mm at Bogra, 27 mm at Chulmari, 25 mm at Habiganj, 21.7 mm at Kaunia during last 24 hours.

Bangabandhu Murder Case

BCL demands
execution of
verdict

2 robberies
Valuables worth
over Tk 4 lakh
looted in city

Robbers looted gold ornaments, cash and other valuables worth over Tk 4.27 lakh in two separate incidents early yesterday morning.

A gang of robbers numbering about six entered the house of one Malik Sahidullah at East Ujan of Rampura after cutting open the grill of the house at about 3 am yesterday.

The gang looted Tk 28,000 along with 13 tolas of gold ornaments and saving certificates worth Tk 2 lakh at gunpoint.

A case was filed with Khilgaon in this regard.

In the other incident, a gang of ten robbers entered a residence at 18/18 Haji Khorsheed Ali Road at Jurain at 3:30 am yesterday after knocking at the door.

They confined the inmates of the house into a room and looted Tk 22,000 in cash and gold ornaments worth about Tk 1.5 lakh at gunpoint.

A case was filed with Shyamprap police station in this regard and police arrested two people, Shakil and Jewel.
