'Tremendous progress achieved in anti-polio campaign'

UNICEF lauds Bangladesh

The UNICEF yesterday lauded Bangladesh for 'tremendous progress achieved in anti-polio campaign', reports BSS. A UNICEF delegation led by its country representative Ms Shahida Azfar yesterday conveyed the message when they called on Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina at her office in the morning to appraise her about the state of polio eradication programme across the country.

"We are very much aware of the sincere efforts of the Bangladesh government for the progress in immunisation programme," Ms Azfar said.

She said we have come here to seek your further support and guidance. The delegation members pointed out that eradication of polio from Bangladesh is part of an international effort where every partner played a vital role.

"The efforts of Bangladesh and other partners had so far been extremely successful. The government and the people of Bangladesh must take the

greatest credit for this success. We are nearly half way down the path, we must redouble our efforts to win the race," the members of the delegation observed.

No polio virus has yet been identified this year in Bangladesh, UNICEF delegation said.

As the Father of the Nation Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman spearheaded small pox eradication efforts 25 years ago so now is the daughter Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina may lead her people to a polio free future, they noted.

Man attacked with machete in Sabujbagh

Miscreants attacked a young man with a machete, wounding him critically, and also cut off tendons from his hand at Manda in city's Sabujbagh area early yesterday.

The victim Alamgir Hossain Ripon, 25, son of Jainul Kader a residence of Uttar Manda came under attack by six miscreants when he was returning home.

Anwar, the victim's elder sister, said that her brother, a garments factory was also working as a police source. He might have been attacked by the miscreants for providing information to the police against them.

Police quoting other relatives of the victim said that Alamgir had also earlier protested immoral activities carried out by the gang in the area.

The 6 men swooped on Alamgir when Ripon reached a shop near Manda bridge at about 1:45 am on his way home.

The gang hit indiscriminately him with a machete and out off his tendons on his hands and legs. Ripon was rushed to the Dhaka Medical College Hospital in a critical condition at about 2:30 pm.

Abdul Kader, the victim's brother-in-law filed a case with Sabujbagh police.

2 hurt in separate incidents in city

Two people were injured critically in separate incidents in the city yesterday.

Abul Basher, a shop employee at Killamore of Labagh in the city sustained injuries when local hoodlums exploded crackers in front of his shop yesterday morning, hospital sources said.

A day earlier, the miscreants demanded free cold drinks from the shop Tuhin Shambher but had been refused. They left the scene after threatening the shopkeeper.

They appeared at shop again yesterday and exploded crackers in front at about 7:30 am. Basher was rushed to the Dhaka Medical College Hospital with critical burn injuries.

In another incident yesterday, Anwar Hossain, 55, of Gupibaghbar was shot during a gun fight between two rival groups of the local miscreants at about 1 pm.

The two groups of local miscreants locked into a clash and traded gunshots over supremacy in the area. Anwar was hit on his jaw and was sent to the DMCH in a critical condition.
