Such offences done directly or indirectly to lower the prestige or dignity of the court may be taken into cognizance, the law explained.

By Staff Correspondent Ershad-led Jatiya Party has charged its Presidium Member Jahangir Mohammad Adel with violating the party constitution by hoisting Pakistan's national flag atop his house on the independence day of Pakistan.

Party's Secretary General Naziur Rahman Manzur yester day served a notice on Adel ask ing him to show cause within 15 days as to why punitive action should not be taken against him for hoisting of Pakistan's flag, which resulted in an "unwanted" incident.

Meanwhile, Adel regretted the hoisting of the Pakistani flag atop his house in the city but blamed his political rivals for the incident.

An Awami League leader, Kamal Hossain was killed in clashes on Tuesday over hoist ing of the flag on the top of Adel's house at Abul Khairat Road in the old part of the city the day before.

"An over enthusiastic person might have hoisted a Pakistan sports flag atop my house on August 14 (the independence day of Pakistan), which was absolutely beyond my knowledge," the JP presidium member said in a statement last night.

He also suspected his politi cal rivals in the locality for doing the act taking advantage of free access to his house he described as political nerve of the area and later informing the newspapers of the incident.

"Whatever the case might have been. I am shocked and ashamed of the whole affair.'
