Judges' accountability to executive organ ruled out

Seminar on judiciary held at JU

SAVAR, Aug 20: Accountability of the judiciary to the citizens is beyond question, but the judges will certainly not remain accountable to the executive body or the legislative body; rather their accountability should be reflected and expressed by their verdicts approved by the Constitution, said Prof Ataur Rahman Khan at the seminar, arranged by the International Relations Department of Jahangirnagar University on the issue "Accountability of the Judiciary" held today, reports BSS.

Referring to the case of Hal-

Department Chairman Prof Ataur Rahman Khan and Asif Bin Iqbal presented the key note papers on "Accountability of the judiciary and the ownership of the People's Republic of Bangladesh" and "Freedom and Accountability of the Judiciary" respectively in the seminar.

Prominent political thinker Prof Sardar Fazlul Karim presided over the seminar.

Asif Bin Iqbal said, "It deserves the consideration how much transparency lies in respect of appointment of judges, as head of the government is empowered in the appointment which often results in the allegation of partial appointment."

Prof Khan stated, "It is unfortunate for Bangladesh that in a number of cases between 1977 and 1980, some judges for-

getting the constitutional existence and breaking their oath taken as judges declared the proclamation and orders of the military ruler as the 'Supreme Law' of the country which resulted in the cancellation of the constitutional sovereignty of the People's Republic of Bangladesh.

ima Khatun vs State (1978) he said, "Since the case was disposed of in the Supreme Court, the highest court of the country and its verdict declared the proclamations of the military ruler as the supreme law, it led to a legal system in Bangladesh under which the will and proclamations of the autocratic rulers subsequently became the supreme law of the country".

He urged the political leaders, intellectuals and cultural activists of the country to find a way out of this awesome state as the People's Republic of Bangladesh came in to being not by the verdict of any judge or court but rather by the ceaseless struggle of the people and a bloody war.

Two injured as minibus hits rickshaw on DU campus

A rickshaw-puller along with his passenger were injured when a minibus hit the rickshaw near Raju Memorial Sculpture at the road island of Teachers and Students Centre (TSC) on the Dhaka University campus at noon yesterday.

Students of the university, however, managed to stop the bus after the accident and police arrested the driver and seized the bus.

Both the injured were taken to the Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH). However, their identity could not be known.

The Dhaka University authorities has set up checkpoints at all the entry points of the campus and put up speed breakers on each road to stop plying of heavy and unwanted vehicles in the area after the death of a BBA student in a road accident on the campus last year.

"Despite the checkpoints and traffic rules on the campus, these types of vehicles sometimes ply on the campus area due to the traffic jams on the roads and the decision of traffic department of the police", an official said.
