Reinforce anti-mosquito drive
Leading physicians urge government

Leading physicians of the country urged the government yesterday to take immediate steps to reinforce the anti-mosquito drive to contain the outbreak of dengue fever, reports BSS.

At least 2.5 to 3 billion people across the world are at risk of getting affected by dengue fever (DF) — DHF (Dengue Haemorrhagic Fever) and DSS (Dengue Shock Syndrome).

Different factors like absence of effective mosquito control measures, unprecedented population boom, uncontrolled urbanisation, deterioration of public health infrastructures and increased air travels has contributed to reemergence of dengue hazards, the doctors said at scientific seminar on 'Dengue Fever' in the city.

Continued medical education (CME) programme of the Department of Medicine of Shaheed Suhrawardy Hospital organised the seminar at its conference hall at Sher-e-Bangla Nagar Pharmaceutical company Eskayef Bangladesh Limited co-hosted the seminar.

Dr MA Jallil Chowdhury said we should ensure immediate oxygen links for DSS patients while routine tests of blood components are needed for DHF patients. He said proper scientific investigation is a must to treat all haemorrhagic patients.

Dr Nigar S Shahid of ICDDR,B said improved water supply and storage, solid waste management using 3Rs (Reduce, Reuse and Recycle) along with manipulation of the environmental situation to create unfavourable condition for vector breeding is a must to contain the disease.
