Cronje may've to compensate 'em

JOHANNESBURG, Aug 28 (Internet Report): However much money Hansie Cronje earns from assorted interviews and book deals, at least some of it may have to be used to pay the legal costs of his former teammales.

Weekend reports suggest that both the United Cricket Board (UCB) and South African players are considering instituting and Henry Williams from civil claims against Cronje to recover costs incurred by their appearances before the King them both for their role in the Commission of Inquiry.

According to the Afrikaans daily Beeld, lawyer Peter Whelan who represents 37 South African players said: "I can confirm that we are giving serious consideration to possi- had decided to impose light senble civil action against Cronje."

It is estimated that the cost of legal fees to the players as a result of Cronje's actions is in excess of R400 000.


