

Bangladesh and Bhutan have agreed to work together to bolster their existing trade and investment relations, reports

The two countries reached a consensus at a formal meeting at the state guest house 'Padma'

here vesterday. Commerce Secretary Golam Rahman and Bhutanese Foreign Secretary Dasho Ugyen shering led their respective sides at the meeting.

Taking stock of the present bilateral trade between the two countries, the meeting reviewed various proposals, including tariff facilities.

The two sides also agreed to ease export-import process and increase warehouse facility in border areas.

Apart from SAPTA, different aspects of increasing trade between the two countries on the basis of bilateral discussion also came up in the meeting for discussion.

Chairman of Bangladesh Tariff Commission AYBI Siddique, Vice-chairman of Export Promotion Bureau (EPB) AB Chowdhury, Bhutanese Ambassador in Dhaka Dasho Lhatu Wangchuk and senior officials of the two countries were present.



made profit in three financial years, they incurred huge loss in the last four consecutive years. The yearly loss stood at Tk two crore on average, according to an official.

The gardens are located at Satgaon, Bhatera, Rupaichhara and Shahjibazar. Local rubber industries were the main buyers of the rubber. But they have lost
