## Anti-hartal processions in city

Mundreds of anti-hartal mpaigners of Bangladesh ami League and its front ornisations marched across sterday different city streets lanting slogans and carrying acards to protest the counrywide day-long hartal enorced by BNP led four-party opposition alliance, reports

The leaders and workers of Bangladesh Awami League and ts front organisations includng Dhaka Mahanagar Awami League, Bangladesh Krishak League, Bangladesh Awami Jubo League, Jatiya Rickshaw ramik League, Bangladesh hhatra League, Bangladesh Wami Olama League, Bangladesh Awami Sechhasebak League, Bangabandhu Soinik League, Bangladesh Hawkers League, Bangladesh Muktijoddha Janata League, Dhaka Mohanagar Chhatra League (South). Bangladesh Awami League's unit in the ward number 56 and Lalbagh thana unit of Awami Sechhasebak League took part in different processions which marched across the city streets.

City Awami League General Secretary and State Minister for Shipping Mofazzal Hossain Chowdhury Maya (Bir Bikram) led the biggest procession which began from the Awami League central office at Bangabandhu Avenue.

## Call for evolving orderly labour migration regime

A South-Asian meeting on migration ended in the city yesterday with a call to evolve an orderly labour migration regime beneficial to both sending and receiving countries for effectively managing the global

flow of labour, reports BSS. Participants in the two-day discussion suggested that a "comprehensive national policy" should be formulated as a first step toward establishing this proposed rule conference sources said.

The meeting was jointly or ganised by the International Organisation for Migration (IOM). Inter-Governmental Asia-Pacific Consultations on Refugees, Displaced Persons and Migrants (APC) and Government of Bangladesh. It was inaugurated by Labour and Employment Minister M A Mannan at Pan Pacific Sonargaon Hotel on Tuesday.

Pakistan, Sri Lanka, IOM, UNHCR and APC participated in the meeting which was presided over by Labour and Secretary Employment Mohammad Sirajul Islam.

The participants in their non-binding recommendations said the government, private sector and civil society should form a strategic partnership in managing temporary labour migration to be supported by the international community.

They also identified some priority areas including institution building, information dissemination, pre-departure training, remittance management and reintegration of re-

turn migrants. There was also a general consensus that South Asian countries should jointly work towards building a regional framework for orderly and humane movement of labour across border, the sources said.

The 30-nation APC is a Bangkok-based body which promotes dialogue and explores opportunities for greater regional cooperation on population movements in collaboration with the IOM headquar tered in Geneva.

Frank recommendations of such meetings, non-binding in nature, are communicated to the respective member nations for consideration.


