## BFUJ meets today

National Professor Kabir Chowdhury will preside over the rally where renowned educationists and national leaders will speak.

## Flood situation static

The overall flood situation across the country remained static following heavy downpour during the last 24 hours till 9 am yesterday, reports UNB.

Flood Forecasting and Warning Centre said, the flood situation between Goalundo and Bhagyakul and flash flood situation in the greater Sylhet are likely to remain unchanged till 9 am today.

Light to moderately heavy rainfall was recorded at all places over the Brahmaputra and Meghna basins and light to heavy at most places with heavy at one or two places over the Ganges and the South Eastern Hill basin during the period.

The Brahmaputra-Jamuna and the Padma experienced fresh rise at all points except at Rajshahi. Most of the rivers in the Meghna recorded rise and the rivers in the SE Hill basin rise and fall during the period.

Out of 46 water level stations monitored by the centre, three points showed above danger level, 30 points recorded rise, 11 points fall and one

point remained static. The Padma registered rise by 3cm at Pankha, 2 cm each at Goalundo and Bhagyakul, slight rise at Hardinge Bridge while the river remained steady at Rajshahi. The river was flowing 19cm above the danger mark at Bhagyakul.

The Meghna registered a rise by 19cm at Kanaighat, 2cm at Sylhet while it receded by 4cm at Sunanganj. The river was flowing 46cm above the danger level at Kanaighat.

The Kushiyara receded by 2cm each at Amalshid and Sheola and it was flowing 9cm above the red mark at Amalshid.

## Discussion on UN millennium summit held

To commemorate the Millennium Summit of the United Nations scheduled to be held at UN Headquarters in New York from September 6-8, a discussion meeting followed by video show was held on August 31, 2000 at the Scholastica School in the city, says a press release.

Organised jointly by the United Nations Information Centre (UNIC) and LIFE -- an anti-drug organisation, the meeting was presided over by the Vice-Principal of Scholastica Ifat Rahman.

Those who addressed the function included Kazi Ali Reza, Officer-in-Charge of UNIC, Geeta Sethi, Country Programme Adviser of UNICEF, Kamrul Islam Sony, Chairman of LIFE, Dr. Abul Hasnat Milton SG of LIFE, and Afroza Khaled Vice-Principal of Scholastica. The programme was conducted by Moniruzzaman of UNIC.

A UN film screening and distribution of UN documents were part of the function.

## College student killed in road accident

RAJSHAHI, Sept 1: A college student was killed and 30 other people were injured when a bus plunged into a roadside ditch at Madhupukur in Mohanpur upazila on Thursday evening, reports UNB.

Witnesses said a passenger bus bound for Naogaon from here rammed a tree and skidded into a ditch at Soipara at 6 pm.

The dead was identified as Harun-or-Rashid, 19. He died on the spot.

Fifteen of the injured were admitted to Rajshahi Medical College Hospital and the rest to Mohanpur Upazila Health Complex.
