

Different sectional offices will remain open-according to academic schedule all classes will start from September 10 again.


The Padma at Bhagyakul, Surma at Kanaighat and Kushiyara at Amalshid are flowing above their respective danger levels, according to a bulletin of Flood Forecasting Centre yesterday.

The Brahmaputra-Jamuna receded at the upstream points but the Padma marked further rise at all points except at Bhagyakul, where the river was still flowing 18 cm above its danger mark.

The Surma registered fall all Kanaighat, Sylhet and Sunamganj but it was flowing 39 cm above red mark. The Kushiyara remained steady at Amalshid and was still above danger mark by 9 cm.

The Manu at Moulvibazar and Railway Bridge, the Khowal at Habiganj and the Gumti at Comilla marked rise, the Meghna receded at Bhairab Bazar and was flowing slightly below danger level.

The rivers in the southeast-
ern hill basin marked rise and
fall, the bulletin said.



The Abul Mansur Ahmad Memorial Committee has drawn up an elaborate programme to mark the occasion.

The programme includes paying respect to the late leader through visit to his graveyard at the Sher-e-Bangla Nagar in the morning. Special prayers and *quran khwani* will be held at Mymensingh and Dhaka res-

The late leader was the senior vice president of East Pakistan Awami Muslim League when it was founded in the late fifties. The word 'Muslim' was subsequently dropped from its nomenclature to allow members of other communities to become its member on the proposal of the leader.

The concept of secularism was first pronounced and popularised by his powerful writings. It was Abul Mansur Ahmad who in his five hour speech in May 1957 in Pakistan Parliament described Pakistan as a country with two distinct peoples with different language, culture and habits.

He also described Pakistan as having a unique system where the majority is ruled by the minority. The late leader played a leading role in formation of the 21-point election manifesto of the United Front in the election of 1954, which brought the Muslim League to power.

This formed the basis of 11-point and 6-point programmes of 1967 and 1970 which later became the one-point programme for liberation in 1971.

The late leader was awarded the highest Civil Award 'Shadhinata Purashkar' posthumously in 1979.

Amongst various other awards, he accepted only the Sher-e-Bangla Gold medal and the Bangladesh Academy Award which he himself had established.

BNP Secretary General Abdul Mannan Bhuiyan MD who is undergoing treatment at the National Institute of Cardiovascular Diseases, has further improved.

He was hospitalised following a cardiac arrest on August 30.

BNP's assistant office secretary Syed Emran Saleh Prince, quoting doctors of the NICVD, said Bhuiyan is steadily improving and started normal activities from yesterday.

He said Bhuiyan was shifted to cabin from Coronary Care Unit (CCU) yesterday and walked for a while, took medicine himself.

The BNP secretary general may be released from hospital within next five to six days if the current trend of improvement continues, the doctors said as quoted by Prince. He added that the medical board reviewed the case of Mammun Bhuiyan and has expressed satisfaction over the improvement.

Meanwhile, a *milad mahfi* was organised at the BNP central office yesterday afternoon for early recovery of the party secretary general. Leaders and activists of the party attended the *milad* and prayed for his early recovery.

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina yesterday announced a Tk 50,000 donation to the family of Alfred Soren, an aborigine leader of Naogaon, who was brutally killed last month, reports UNB.

She also declared Tk 10,000 as donation for each of the families affected or rendered homeless in the terrorist attack at Bhimpur village in Mohadevpur upazila over a land dispute.

The Prime Minister said the homeless *Santhal* families would be provided shelter at *Ashrauan* project in the dis-

On August 18, some miscreants attacked the *Santhal* village, hacked Alfred Soren to death and set fire to the houses to capture 200 bighas of disputed land in the upazila.
