CSIT course of Military Instt commences

The Academic session of Computer Science and Information Technology (CSIT) Course of the Military Institute of Science and Technology (MIST), Mirpur, began in the city yesterday. Fifty-three officers of the armed forces are taking part in the three-year long course, an ISPR press release said, reports BSS.

Chief of the Army Staff Lieutenant General Muhammad Mustafaizur Rahman, Bir Bikram, formally inaugurated the course as the chief guest.

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina had inaugurated the Institute in April 1998 at Mirpur Cantonment and academic activities began the following year with the institution of B.Sc. Civil Engineering course with 40 army officers. Dhaka University has approved its affiliation.

In March this year, classes for the second batch of B.Sc. Civil Engineering began. And on April 18, began MBA Course of the Institute with 45 armed forces officers on the roll.

The main objectives of the CSIT course is to enable the armed forces to meet the need of the time in keeping with the rapid changes in information and computer technology of the 21st century.

BSC invites applications for 200 scholarships
