'Govt to explore options for improving health services'

Health and Family Welfare Minister Sheikh Fazlul Karim Selim said in the city yesterday that the government is committed to exploring the options available for improvements in hospital-based services to the people, reports BSS.

Addressing the inaugural function of a workshop of strategic planning on Hospital Improvement Initiative (HII), he said "Government hospitals have an important role within our health care delivery system in meeting the needs of the curative health of the members of our communities."

But, the minister said, "We must realistic in our appraisal of existing services and accept that the pressures on our hospitals and the present deficiencies have affected their performance."

Sheikh Selim said the government's HII within the Health and Population Sector Programme has been designed to work with the hospital management as well as stakeholders in developing sustainable improvements through greater teamwork, better efficiency and acceptable community input.

He explained that the initiative is designed to improve the performance of government hospitals through improving management capacity and at the same time linked those with new management systems including ledgerary systems, information systems, quality assurance, increased delegation of authority and strategic planning.

The Minister informed the workshop that the initiative is currently applied in five government hospitals in Sylhet region but the programme is designed for future expansion to all government hospitals to ensure uniform quality and provision of services in all hospitals throughout the country.

The Health Minister said he had recently approved the setting up of internal management committees in five hospitals and the establishment of local advisory committees, headed by the respective Member of Parliament and with several important local leaders and representatives as members to provide community feedback and support for improving services.

The minister underlined the need for planning at all levels to maximise the use of resources available and target the priority needs facing the healthcare system. Sheikh Selim said the development of the strategic planning in hospitals will gradually be coordinated with the allocation of funds and annual budgets within each family to ensure proper use of resources.

He said "It is important to note that the government is looking at ways of sustaining improvements of the initiative and providing local resource allocations to supplement planning and quality improvements."

State Minister for Health and Family Welfare Prof M Amanullah also spoke on the occasion as the special guest.

The inaugural session chaired by Health Secretary Sayed Alamgir Farouk Chowdhury, was addressed among others, by Hospitals Director Dr Moazzam Hoque and Director General of Health Services Prof ABM Ahsanullah.
