PM opens Faridpur digital telephone exchange

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina opened a digital telephone exchange in Faridpur yesterday saying her government attaches priority to telecommunication and IT sector to keep abreast of global advancement, reports UNB.

She inaugurated the 7,000-line digital telephone exchange by talking over telephone from her office to Post and Telecommunications Minister Mohammad Nasim in Faridpur.

"Since we cannot afford to lag behind the advancement of world information technology, our government has given special emphasis on this sector," the Prime Minister said.

Under the project financed by the Chinese government, existing 2,800-line analogue telephone lines are being transformed into digital lines.

The Prime Minister said Faridpur district with rich tradition and history was neglected since 1975. She said Faridpur would now be getting benefit of her government's various socio-economic development plans being implemented throughout the country.

With the setting up of this digital exchange, Faridpur became the 31st district to have digital telephone network. Ha-

sina assured that remaining districts would be brought under the project in phases. The Prime Minister also talked to Environment Minister Sveda Sajeda Chowdhury, State Minister for Post and Telecommunications, Abdul Rouf Chowdhury, President of Faridpur Chamber of Commerce and Industries Khandaker Mosharraf Hossain and Chairman of Faridpur Municipality Hasibul Hasan.

Chinese Ambassador to Bangladesh Hu Qianwen was present at the PM's office on the occasion.

Chinese team arrives Oct 4

A four-member delegation of Chinese People's Association for Friendship with Foreign Countries (CPAFFC) arrives in the city on October 4 on a week-long goodwill visit to Bangladesh, reports UNB.

The delegation, led by Su Guang, Vice President of CPAFFC, will participate in a discussion to be organised by Bangladesh-China People's Friendship Association (BCPEA) at a city hotel.

The discussion meeting will be arranged to mark the 25th anniversary of establishing diplomatic tie between Bangladesh and China and the 51st founding anniversary of People's Republic of China. Industries Minister Tofail Ahmed will attend the function as chief guest while State Minister for Foreign Affairs Abul Hasan Chowdhury and Chinese Ambassador to Bangladesh Hu Qianwen will be present as special guests.

Hasna Hena Qadir Smriti Parishad formed

'Shaheed Jaya Hasna Hena Qadir Smriti Parishad', has been formed here to uphold the memory of late Hasna Hena Qadir, reports UNB.

The council has been constituted with Poet Shamsur Rahman as its convenor and journalist Nadeem Qadir member secretary, said a press release.

Hasna Hena Qadir, who died of respiratory complications on November 12, 1999, was the wife of Shaheed Lt Col M Abdul Qadir who embraced martyrdom in the 1971 liberation war.

She was one of the founders of 'Ekatturer Ghatik Dalal Nirmul Committee' and also involved in different social movements.

In its first initiative, the Parishad will award a reporter every year for an in-depth or research oriented report on the Liberation War. Dhaka Reporters' Unity will cooperate with the Parishad in this regard.

Apart from a crest and a citation, the award will carry a cash prize of Tk 10,000, the release added.
