

# BRAC to import hybrid paddy seeds this month

BRAC becomes the first NGO to import hybrid paddy seeds in the country.

Aminul Alam, Deputy Executive Director of the country's leading non-government organisation, told The Daily Star that BRAC would import hybrid paddy seed 'GB4' from China this month.

This would be the fifth hybrid rice variety being imported in the country. Earlier on September 9, 1998, the government gave permission to four private companies, for the first time, to import hybrid paddy seeds.

"Government permitted us to bring in seeds of rice hybrid from abroad but we have to grow the seeds locally by 2001 for sale in the domestic market," explained Alam.

The government allowed the private companies to import seeds on condition that the importers have to produce those locally by 2001.

The importers of hybrid paddy seeds are Advanced Chemical Industries (ACI) Ltd., Ganges Development Corporation, McDonald Bangladesh Private Ltd., and Mallika Seed Company. They imported 'Alok 6201', 'Amar Sri 1', 'Loknath

503' and 'CNSG 6' hybrid varieties respectively. First three varieties are from India while the last one is from China.

BRAC has signed an agreement with Hitech Seed of Sichuan, China, for importing one metric tons of foundation seeds of GB4 hybrid paddy.

"Five Chinese experts are also coming to Dhaka next month to impart training on hybrid seed production. We'll have our field trials at Bhaluka, Mymensingh," said Alam.

Since 1998, BRAC has been marketing hybrid paddy seeds 'Alok' imported by ACI.

When contacted, FH Ansary, Executive Director of the agro-business wing of the ACI, told this correspondent that BRAC would continue to market a substantial volume of ACI's hybrid paddy seeds in the domestic market.

BRAC said it marketed 204 MT of hybrid rice seeds in 1998 and 477 MT in 1999.

Besides, BRAC also produced 1340 MT of rice seeds of high yielding varieties (HYV) in 1999-2000. It has set a production target of 3000 MT of HYV rice seed for 2000-2001.

BRAC is using HYV varieties released by the Bangladesh

Rice Research Institute (BRRI) in producing the paddy seeds. Alam said BRAC has signed memorandum of understanding (MOUs) with different public sector research institutions, including BRRI, BARI and BINA, for cooperation in seed development, technology transfer and agricultural extension.

Though BRAC has been in seed business for over three years now, it came under criticism for crop failures in different parts of the country, allegedly because of low-quality seeds.

Alam defended his organisation, saying that "Seed is a factor in crop production. But success in production depends on many other factors like soil moisture, land fertility, proper timing and application of fertiliser."

He, however, said that BRAC paid Tk. 20 lakh to the affected farmers last year as compensation for crop failures in onion. "We got that consignment of onion seeds from ACI," Alam added.

Last year, BRAC sold vegetable seeds worth Tk nine crore. In addition, BRAC deals in wheat and maize seeds.

## Independence Memorial Museum to be set up in Ctg

CHITTAGONG, Oct 1: The newly formed Swadhinata Smriti Trust (SSST) will set up an Independence Memorial Museum in the port city of Chittagong where from the proclamation of independence was first read out in 1971, reports BSS.

According to a project concept paper prepared by the trust the museum will be enriched with all documents, facts and history of the country's War of Liberation.

As part of the project, the trust will also carry out a thorough research to evaluate the contributions of freedom fighters to the next generation could learn about the genocide and brutality perpetrated by the Pakistani occupation army during the Liberation War.

The trust, a conglomerate of freedom fighters and people of different professions belonging to the pro-liberation camp, will make a complete list of the war criminals, unearth the clandestine misdeeds of their aides and forge a movement for their trial, member secretary of the trust journalist Nasir Uddin Chowdhury said.

## Int'l Day of Older Persons observed

As the mortality rate of country is decreasing, the government is under pressure to launch projects for the elderly people, speakers said yesterday at a programme marking the International Day of Older Persons.

Department of Social Services held a programme at the Social Welfare Building premises in the city's Agargaon area yesterday in observance of the day. Minister for Food Amir Hossain was the chief guest and State Minister of Social Welfare Dr. Mozammel Hossain was the special guest at the programme.

"Today is the UN declared International Day of Older Persons. Our slogan for the day is to build a society for all ages. Our government has already initiated schemes for establishing six 'Shantinivas', (homes for the elderly people) at six divisional cities of the country," Minister of Food said in his speech.

Earlier a colourful procession was brought out from the IDB Bhaban in the city's Agargaon area at 10am which paraded different city streets. A good number of elderly people, both men and women, participated in the day's programmes.

It will also conduct extensive survey on identification and digging out the killing spots, mass-graves and front-line fields, he said adding that memorial plaques will be erected on those places.

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina has been proposed to be the chief patron of the trust which comprises 25 members with Prof. Anupom Sen as its Chairman.

The other patrons of the trust are veteran freedom fighters commander of sector-1 during Liberation War Major (Rtd) Rafiqul Islam (Bir Uttam), Labour and Employment Minister M.A. Mannan, Civil Aviation, Tourism, Public Works and Housing Minister Engineer Mosharraf Hossain and Chittagong City Mayor A.B.M. Mohtuddin Chowdhury.

## Woman strangled to death by husband in Lalbagh

A young woman was strangled to death, allegedly by her husband, at their shanty in the Islambagh slum in city's Lalbagh area yesterday.

Police recovered the body of the 22-year old woman at around 9 am, after being informed about her death by neighbours.

Kamala, the young woman, locked into an altercation with her husband Khokon on Saturday night and at one stage of the quarrel, was strangled to death by him," neighbours said.

They found her body in the morning and informed Lalbagh police.

Ismail, Kamala's brother, told the police that she hailed from Charsampur of Muladi in Barisal but that he was not aware that she had got married.

Neighbours told the police that the Khokon and Kamala had introduced themselves as a couple when they moved into the slum.

A case has been lodged with Lalbagh police.

## 3 killed in bus, truck collision on Dhaka-Sylhet highway

NARSINGDI, Oct 1: Three persons were killed and 30 injured when a Dhaka-bound bus collided head-on with a truck at Shibpur on Dhaka-Sylhet highway today, reports UNB.

Police said the accident took place at about 1 pm at Kundarpara in Shibpur upazila, some 13 km off the district town. All three victims, who could not be identified yet, died on the spot.

Thirteen of the injured persons were sent to Dhaka Medical College Hospital. Eleven of them were identified as Noorjahan, 30, Faruque, 28, Nirmla, 60, Tanzila, 2, Rafeza, 40, Mozaffar, 28, Shahjahan, 25, Ali, 28, Asadullah, 26, Jasim, 32, and Rashedul, 22.

"Condition of five of those sent to DMCH is critical," one of the attending physicians here told UNB.

The rest were admitted to Narsingdi Sadar Hospital. The bodies were also sent to the same hospital for autopsy.

Police seized both the vehicles, but the drivers managed to escape. A case was filed with Shibpur police.


