Taekwondo, originating in Korea more than 2,000 years ago, means "the way of hand and foot" in Korean. It is also a philosophy or a way of life to its practitioners, typified by the Koreans limiting their own number of qualifiers for the Olympics to encourage greater global participation.

Kim Kyong-Hun outclassed local hero Daniel Trenton Saturday to grab South Korea's third taekwondo gold in the heavyweight final. Greece, the United States, Cuba, Australia and China each won one gold medal.

Daily protests about the refereeing in taekwondo marred the start but the skill level was high for the kicking and punching sport. And triathlon, which opened the Games more than two weeks ago, quickly grabbed a respected place as a dramatic high point with elements of marathon running, road cycling and distance swimming interwoven to create a magic event.

Anyone who had suggested before the Games that Switzerland's unheralded Brigitte McMahon and Canada's equally unheralded Simon Whitfield would be crowned the first Olympic champions in this most gruelling of sports would have been laughed out of Sydney.
