

Capt Siddique

passes away Sports Reporter

Renowned sports organiser and Bangladesh Olympic Association vice-president Captain Siddique Ahmed (retired) died of a heart attack at the Combined Military Hospital (CMH) early Monday morning. He was 71.



Siddique left behind two sons and a daughter.

A former Dhaka University Blue, he had been suffering from duodenal ulcer for the last two months. During Siddique's chequered

career he served as BOA secrestary general from 1981-91. president of Bangladesh Football Federation from 1979 to 1981 and Bangladesh Wrestling Federation from 1978 to 1996. Siddique, who received Na-Itional Sports Award in 1987. was an elected member of Olympic Council of Asia (OCA) Rules Committee for four years from 1999.

Cairns coming to Nairobi

ICCKnockOut Kenya2000

WELLINGTON. Oct 2 (Internet report): All-rounder Chris Cairns has been named in the New Zealand squad for the ICC Trophy Knockout Tournament in Kenya starting on Tuesday.

> The convenor of selectors, Sir Richard Hadlee, said while there was still a need to reassess the fitness of some players before the next stage of the tour, the six ODIs against South Africa next month, the reports from Zimbabwe were that all in the squad were fit for selection. The exception is Dion Nash who headed back to New Zealand on Monday for assessment and treatment for his injured back.

"After the Nairobi tournament, we will look at how players like Geoff Allott, Chris Cairns and Chris Nevin have come through from injuries which prevented them from taking full part in the justcompleted Zimbabwe series.

"The tournament rules dictate there can only be 14 players in the Knockout squad, so we will omit pace bowler Daryl Tuffey from our named squad. but he will stay on with the party as they will be going straight to South Africa once their involvement in this tournament is over." Hadlee said.

The ICC Knockout Tournament begins on Tuesday in Nairobi with a match between hosts Kenya and India.

Amazingly, these two sides have met six times since their first fixture during the 1996 World Cup. India were only the second top level side that the African side beat, by 69 runs in Gwalior in 1998. The senior team have had the run since

then, however, with three straight wins, including a victory at Bristol during the World Cup and in Nairboi during last year's tournament.


