PM asks Cub Scouts to devote themselves to serve humanity

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina yesterday asked the Cub Scouts to devote themselves to the service of hapless humanity and build up a new leadership imbued with patriotism to steer the nation, reports UNB.

"Groom yourself as worthy citizen with proper education, build up new leadership through Cub movement and lead the nation towards our cherished goal of prosperity," she said speaking at the Shapla Cub Award distribution ceremony at the Osmari Memorial Auditorium.

Several thousand Cub Scouts, both boys and girls, from six divisions assembled at

the function, where the Prime Minister distributed Shapla Cub Awards, highest distinction for the category, among 406 recipients of 1998 and 1999.

At present, there are 548,000 Cub Scouts in the country. Under the Cub Scouting Project, 32,000 teachers of primary schools so far were provided with cub leadership training.

Hasina advised the Cub Scouts to groom themselves as disciplined, truthful, self-respecting and competent citizen by acquiring both theoretical and practical knowledge.

Stressing on the need for

education, she said without learning and knowledge a nation cannot develop and move forward.

The government, she said, has given importance to primary education for ensuring education to all children. Besides, stipends are being given to poor and neglected children to help them continue their studies at school.

The Prime Minister said the government also introduced Cub Scouting in primary school and 'Ebadat' madrassah.

The well-to-do people should come forward to help the poor school children to become educated citizens, she said.

PM to receive money for flood victims

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina will receive money and material for PM's Relief Fund on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday at 1 pm at her office to assist the flood victims, reports UNB.

The charity drive is being launched as lakhs of people remained in misery in relief camps losing their hearth and home in devastating flooding in the country's southwestern frontier districts.

Two killed in road accident at Mohakhali

A man and his four year old son was crushed under the wheels of a truck in front of BRAC center in Mohakhali in the city yesterday evening.

The victims were identified as Mohammad Shamim, a vendor and resident of North Badda in the city and his son Reedy. The mother of the boy travelling with the same rickshaw escaped unhurt, police said.

The incident took place when the rickshaw in which Shamim along with his wife and son were travelling was hit by a speeding truck.

They were sent to the Dhaka Medical College Hospital in a critical condition where the attending doctor declared the father and son dead.

Two commit suicide in city

In separate incidents, a young man and a woman allegedly committed suicide by hanging themselves in the city yesterday.

Wahiduzzaman, 32, son of Alhaj Afsar Uddin, a resident of 44/H Zikatala, Dhanmondi and a salesman of Rahim Afroz of Motijheel, a private firm, committed suicide at his bedroom.

"We entered his bedroom by breaking open the door and found him hanging from the ceiling," Atiquzzaman, brother of the deceased said.

The young man was scheduled to get married today," he added. He was the fourth of six brothers and three sisters.

The body was sent to the Dhaka Medical College Hospital for autopsy.

In another incident, body of a garment employee Sanchita Shikha, 25, a resident of 387/1 Madhubagh, Maghbazar was found hanging from the beam of her house.

The girl was staying there along with her three friends who recently went to visit their village home, police said.

Being informed by local people, police recovered the body last morning.

The body was sent to the DMCH for autopsy.
