## More donations for flood victims

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina yesterday received donations from different individuals and organisations for the relief operations in the flood affected southwestern districts, report agencies.

The donations she received yesterday in cash and cheque amounted to Tk one crore 54 lakh 65,103.

More organisations, including different ministries and government and non-government offices, have donated one day's salary of their officials and employees to the PM's Relief Fund.

These include Industries Ministry Tk 37.63 lakh, Health Ministry Tk 22 lakh, United Commercial Bank Ltd Tk 15 lakh, Civil Aviation Ministry Tk 13.19 lakh, Science and Technology Ministry Tk 3.91 lakh, DESA Tk 2 lakh, Public Health Engineering Department Tk 1.05 lakh, BASIC Bank Tk 1.01 lakh, Anti-corruption Bureau Tk one lakh, Jatiya Mahila Sangstha Tk one lakh, Khulna City Corporation Tk one lakh, BRTA Tk 20,000, Jamuna Bridge Authority Tk 25,589 and Special Security Force Tk 27,000.

Besides, Khulna Power Company gave Tk 10 lakh, Akker Kagoj Tk 10 lakh, Chairman of Narsingdi Pourasabha Tk three lakh, Roads and Highways Department Engineers' Association Tk one lakh, Agrabad Hotel, Chittagong Tk one lakh, Pacific Consultant International Tk one lakh, Prime Group of Industries Tk one lakh, Associated Builders Corporation Tk one lakh and Board of Investment Tk 45,000.


