tact with several people and we will name the coach by the end of the month." he said. Favourites for the post in-

clude Oswaldo Oliveira. Emerson Leao and Rene Simoes. The name of Cruzeiro's Luiz Felipe Scolari has also been mentioned, even though "Big Phil" has already turned down an offer from the CBF. Luxemburgo was dismissed

after disastrous showings with both the senior team in the World Cup qualifiers and then the under-23 side at the Sydney Olympics.

Players' chief blasts deadly

MILAN, Oct 17: Italian Players' Union (AIC) president Sergio Campana Monday slammed the use of what he termed 'dangerous' pitches in Serie A football, reports AFP.

Campana was speaking after a weekend when Sunday's Serie A programme was played in atrocious weather conditions three players were hospitalised in separate incidents.

"Referees have been ordered from up above to play the match whatever and this is worrving," said Campana.

... The fact is in the Italian Championships irregular games are being played with grave danger for the safety of the players, with weighty penalisations for the (quality of the) game with an evident breach of the rights of the spectators. I hope it will not take a fatal event to stop this scandal."

Also Monday Vicenza club doctor Piero Fanton revealed that there had been fears for the welfare of player Giuseppe Cardone, one of the three players hospitalised Sunday - in his case after a clash of heads with Atalanta's Fausto Rossini in the match won 2-1 by Atalanta.

Cardone was unconscious on the field for a minute before the referee authorised the Vicenza staff to treat the player. "He (the referee) told us he had not seen anything and he

then apologised," said Fanton. "I immediately knew it was a serious incident when I saw the player fall to the ground in an uncoordinated manner. When we got to him he was unconscious but was breathing. He was lucky he had his face turned away; if he had fallen with his face to the ground he might have suffocated."

Cardone was reported to have improved Monday but will undergo more tests. A scan has revealed no brain injury.

Bologna players Luis Oliveira and Renato Olive were also hospitalised during their team's 2-1 victory over AC Milan.
