from Nov 5

A five-day International Conference on "Water, Sanitation and Hygiene: Challenges of the Millennium" will begin in the city on November 5, reports BSS.

Experts from home and abroad will take part in the conference sponsored by the Government of Bangladesh, Water, Engineering and Development Centre (WEDC) of the Loughborough University, UK, and the Water and Sanitation Programme of South Asia.

The WEDC that organises international conference every year on water supply and sanitation in the developing countries this time to hold the 26th grand meet of such kind.

More than 500 participants including 150 international experts are expected to participate in the conference.

Army continues

Relief and rehabilitation activities of the Bangladesh armed forces are in full swing in different flood affected areas, an ISPR release said yesterday.

Bangladesh Air Force sent a medical team to Mathekipur in Jhenaidah district on Monday. The team treated 550 people there, provided medicine and advised them to take precautionary steps to prevent water-borne diseases.

A BAF relief team provided cooked food to more than 3,600 people at Jalalpur Dakhil Madrasa centre on Friday and also distributed dry food among them.

The BAF helicopters started para-dropping food and other essentials for the marooned people in the flood affected areas from Thursday. These aircraft ran more than 60 sorties from Jessor to different destinations since October 3.

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

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
