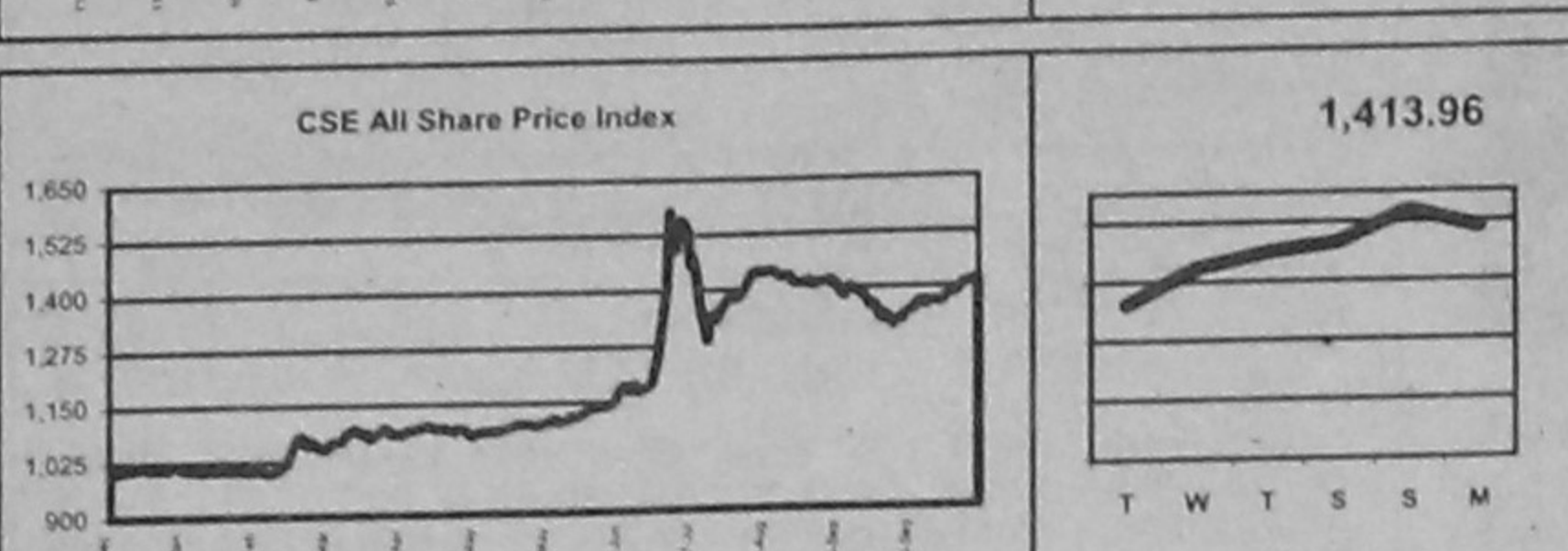
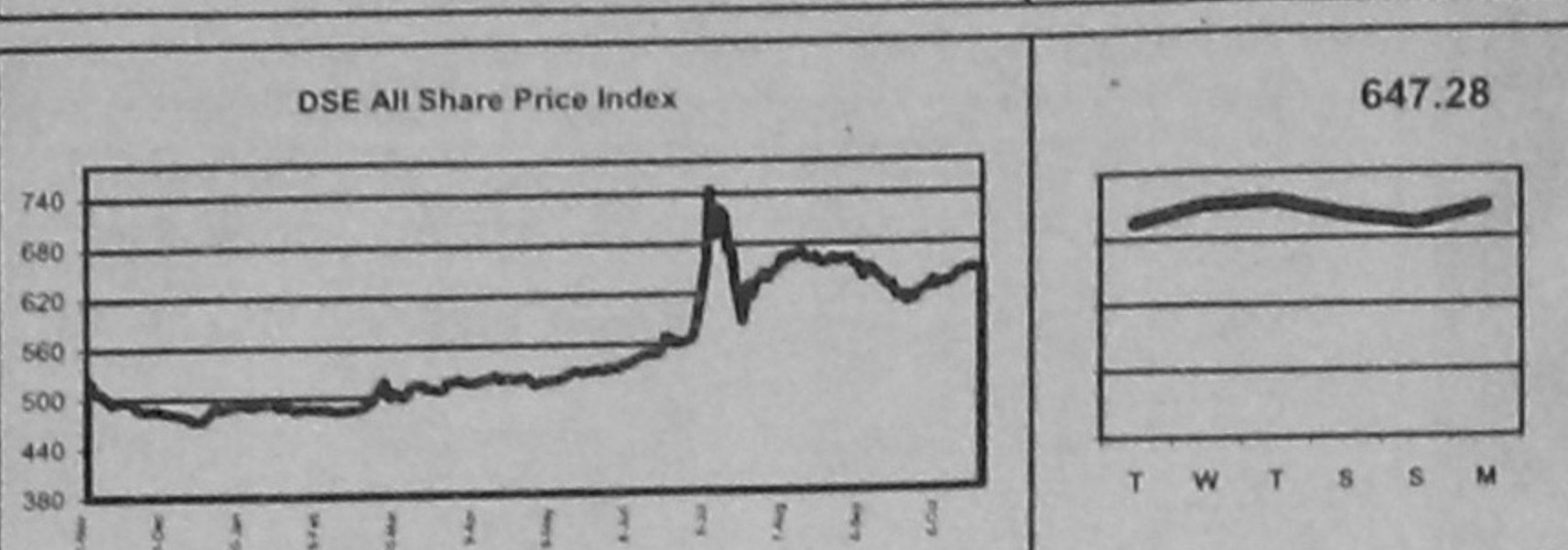
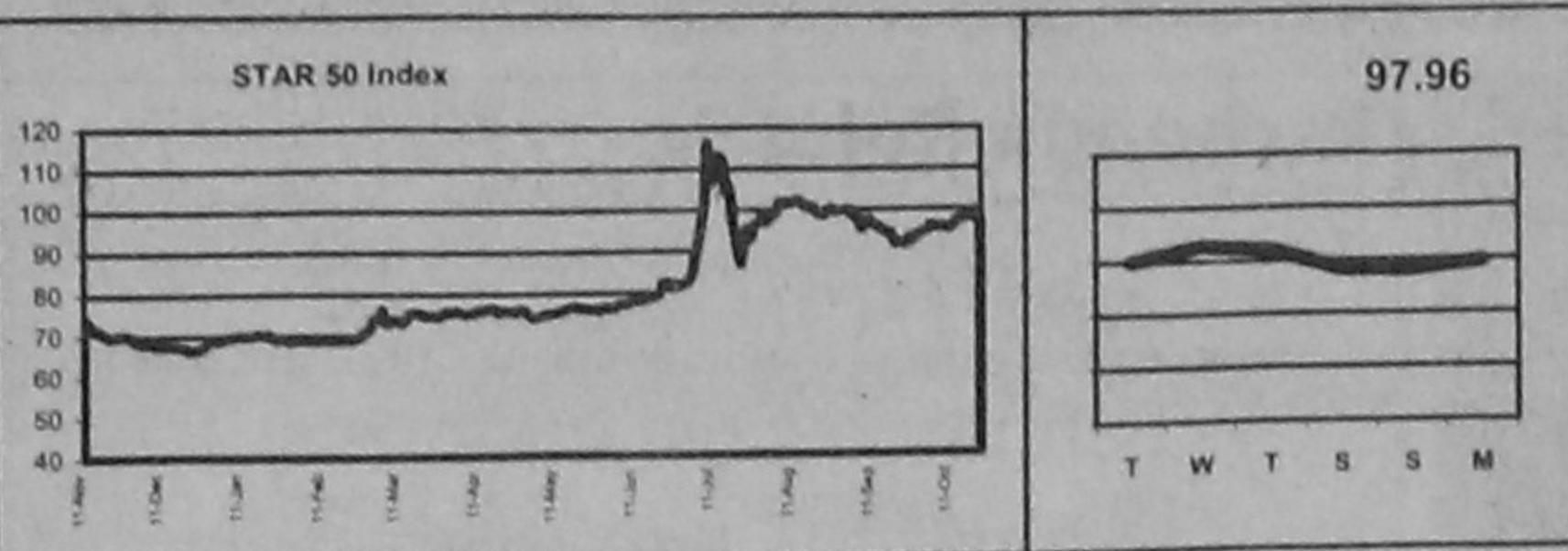

Relatives, friends and admirers have been requested to attend the 'doh mahfil' and pray for salvation of the departed soul.



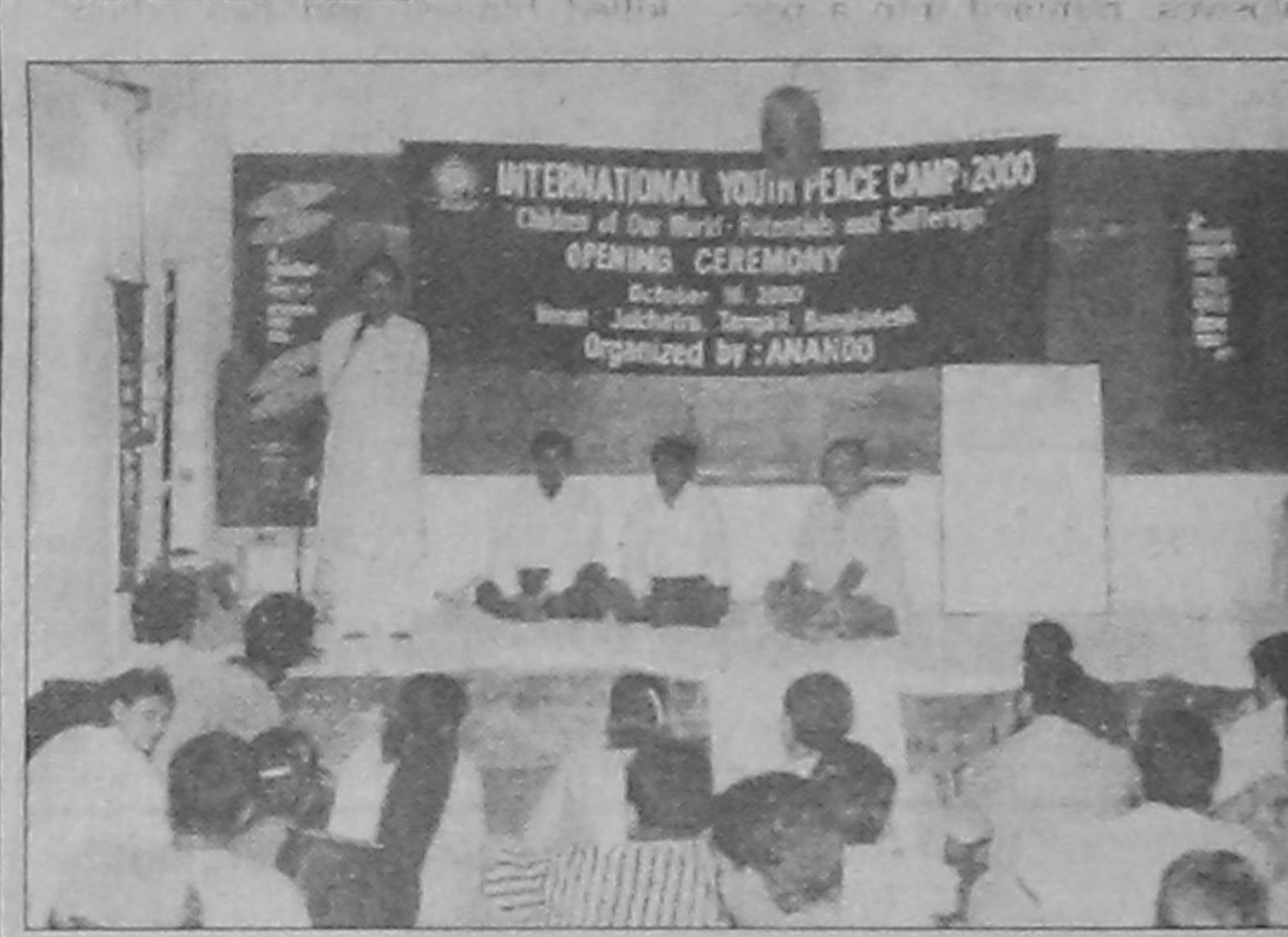
