A photography exhibition by a group of working-class children starts at Drik Gallery

"D R Shahidul Alam introduced us with photography. It all started when we first met him at the veranda of the Ananda Niketan School of Goro Sahajya Sangstha," said one of the young photographers at the inaugural ceremony of their group exhibition yesterday at Drik Gallery premises.

'Out of Focus' is a group of working class children who have been associated with Drik since 1994. They were first featured in Drik's 1997 Calendar. They also held an exhibition in Drik Gallery in the same year. That was the time their journey as photographers began.

of World Press Photo, at the Junior Summit in MIT Media Lab, Boston, and won the 2nd prize in an international photographic competition organised by the UN Children's Fund where they contested against professional lens-men from the region. Their works were exhibited at the United

Nations building in New York and the Photographers Gallery in London. This paved the way to have their works to get wide publicity. Several of these young people are currently working in the Ekushey Television in the children's news clip 'Mukto Khorob'.

The ongoing exhibition titled 'Monoronjon Noi, Obhijatra' contains pictures of mostly poor and working people of the city.

In the beginning they were many, in terms of number. When they were struggling to learn photography, many dropped out. Now there are 10 photographers from Dhaka. The exhibition will also feature works by another group of rural children from Phandauk, a small village near Brahmanbaria, where Drik has been working.

A number of 145 photographs, mostly colour and a few black-and-white by these young and promising people are bound to give rise of hope among the audience. One message is very clear from their works that these photographers worked from their instinct. They pictured those humans whom they could iden-

tify with themselves. That is why most of the objects of their photographs are child labourers.

They feel that a lot of things have changed, as they worked on, which have effected their thoughts and visions. Their technique and manner of clicking cameras have also changed. People praise their work but when they see the cameras they are using, most of them say, 'Oh! You used this camera!'

Drik has an educational fund for this young bunch. It also has fund for their treatment, conveyance and costs that include films and printings. The photographs on display are also for sell.


Most of the pictures feature the slums, working people and their sufferings. What mostly these young photographers feel like capturing is the environment around them and they are observing the contrast in the society. "We are learning photography and taking pictures of child labour, but in fact, we are learn-



The Final Countdown

A film session ends at the Goethe Institut

IN the modern-day world, film has not only been served as a source of entertainment but it has proved to be a powerful medium of documentation. Bangladesh Short Film Forum organised a two-day-long Feature Length Documentary film session at the German Cultural Centre (Goethe Institut) auditorium on October 22 and 23. The Forum screened four films, projecting socio-emotional problems that we are mired in today's world.

"Kirk-Krat" and "What Do Pina Bauch And Her Dancers Do In Wuppertal?" were screened on the inaugural day at 5:30 pm and 7:00 pm respectively.

"Kirk-Krat", a 78-minute documentary on Haiti directed by J. Avila, is about military dictatorship in Latin America and its brutal way of ruling especially in a small country Haiti. "What Do Pina Bauch And Her Dancers Do In Wuppertal?" is a 115-minute German film. It is an observational documentary on one of the most gifted female choreographers of present-day Europe by one of the master of German documentary Klaus

Wilden Hann. Afrique's is an 82-minute documentary. It is on Cameroon directed by Jean Maria Teno. This documentary on Cameroon tells a story, based on facts, about how democracy fares in African continent. The colonial past of the dark continent has been seen through the eyes of a film maker. It was screened on October 23 at 5:30 p.m.

The session ended with the screening of "What Should We Do Without Death" at 7 p.m. on October 23. It's a 98-minute German documentary directed by Elin Mikesch.

The title of the film "What Should We Do Without Death" is the feeling that essentially strikes at the core of problem of the elderly women, more particularly in the context of European social framework. Considering crabbed age as the second phase of childhood, the documentary is an honest documentation of some innermost feelings of old-age women abandoned by their once-

near and dear ones. Old age consciousness among people, especially among women living in old homes, is the focus of this experimental documentary by one of most gifted German female film maker.

The documentary very faithfully and compassionately explores the predicament of the old people left in their sheer vulnerability in every sense of the term. It points at the old people's feelings and suggests that they need to be taken care of affectionately. They want to share many of their unexpressed feelings with others and expect reciprocated responses from others.

The film portrays various childlike, often confused, desires of people of this age group. The old women in the old home express their boredom at their routine life working, taking food, resting and taking medicine. Most often they are confused about how they should pass their time. And mostly they do so by reminiscing the colourful days of their past. What they badly need is support of every kind.

They are a bunch of lonely people in the real sense of the term. The tedious hours, days and months of loneliness are a pain. At this juncture of life, they long for companionship and want to share their innermost feelings with the companion. In the absence of a companion, they suffer from spiritual crises. One woman at the old home expressed her disillusionment over worldly life and never wants a rebirth. Another lady, having lost her husband, appears melancholy and laments her irreparable loss. She expresses an intense longing to get her husband. Their idea of death and afterworld is not very clear. But death something that pre-occupies their mind all the time. Sometimes they go on contemplating death endlessly. One lady describes her hallucination as how death came rushing on a horseback.


