### Mugger beaten up, dies at DMCH

An alleged mugger who was beaten up by a mob on Wednesday died at the Dhaka Medical College Hospital yesterday, hospital sources said.

The dead was identified as Md. Hanif, 28. Local people caught hold of him and beat him up in front of T and T Colony at Maghbazar when he tried to snatch valuables from a woman travelling in a rickshaw in the morning.

Ramna police rescued him in a critical condition and sent him to the Dhaka Medical College Hospital where he died at about 1 pm yesterday.

His body was sent to the DMCH morgue.
