

# Tk 52.9 lakh donated to PM's Relief Fund

Different organisations government offices and individuals donated over Taka 52.98 lakh to the Prime Minister's Relief and Welfare Fund in aid of the flood victims yesterday, reports BSS.

Officials and employees of different government and private offices donated their one-day salary while several individuals including housewives and children contributed in cash to the fund.

## CPB salutes 'Oct Revolution'

# CU admission tests begin today

14 students vying for each seat

CHITTAGONG, Nov 6: The admission tests of the first year honours courses in the University of Chittagong for the Session 2000-2001 will begin tomorrow.

A total of 35,679 candidates are taking part in the admission tests this year for 2484 seats in 32 departments under five faculties and two institutes. About 14 students are vying for each seat, sources said.

According to CU authority, written tests for KA unit (Physical Science and Biological Science) will begin tomorrow with Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Computer Science, Statistics and Zoology. Botany, Biochemistry, Microbiology, Geography and Soil Science exams being held.

Admission tests for Kha unit (Arts) will be held tomorrow. Tests for Ga unit (Commerce), Gha unit (Social Science) and Uma unit (Law) will be held on November 9, November 10 and November 11 respectively.

Admission tests of Forestry Institute and Marine Science Institute will be held on November 11 and November 13 respectively.

This year MCQ (Multiple Choice Question) system has been introduced for the first time in the admission tests of CU.

Meanwhile classes of all the 32 departments of the university will remain suspended from November 7 to November 13 for the admission tests, official sources said.

## Senate meet postponed

The Senate meeting of Chittagong University (CU) scheduled to be held on November 17 has been postponed.

Vice-Chancellor Prof. Abdul Mannan called for the Senate meeting on October 30, but under pressure from the teachers of both the rolling party backed Pink Panel and BNP-Jamaat backed White Panel the meeting was postponed through a notice today.

Teachers from both the Pink and White panels rejected the meeting as the term of the Senate, formed in 1986, expired.
