Jarina wants her money back

Jarina Khatun, whose money was stolen from the luggage at Zia International Airport (ZIA) on November 5 upon her arrival from Abu Dhabi, has expressed determination not to leave Dhaka without recovering her hard-earned money.

She was speaking at a meeting on Wednesday organised by the Welfare Association of Repatriated Bangladeshi Employees (WARBE) at its office in the city, said a press release.

Giving a brief description of her ordeal at ZIA, Jarina said she has become a pauper after some Tk 80,000, that she had earned abroad, was stolen. She is yet to get any compensation from the authorities concerned.
