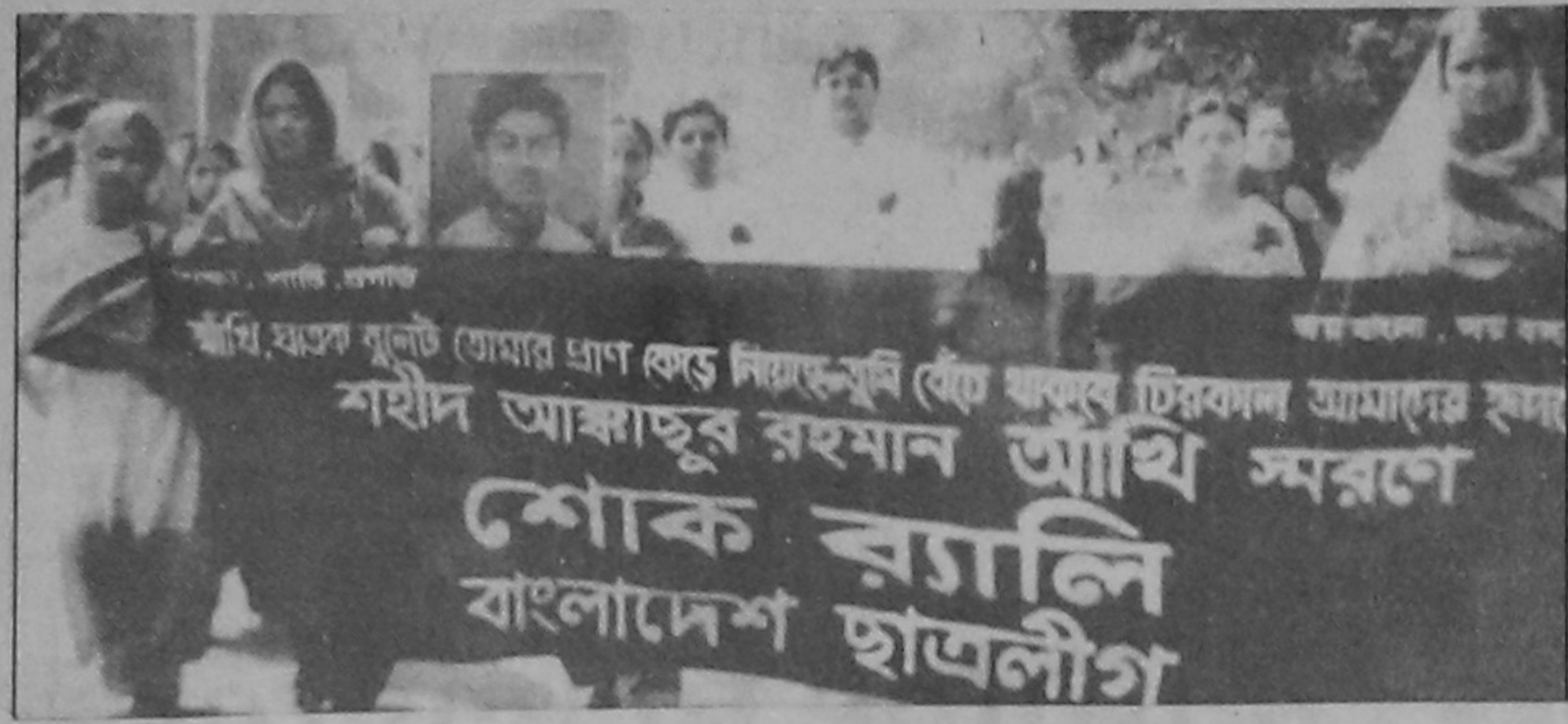

Justice Ruhul Islam dead

Justice Ruhul Islam, a retired judge of the Appellate Division of the Supreme Court and a former Chairman of Bangladesh Press Council died of cardiac arrest on Saturday night at Bangladesh Medical College Hospital, family sources said yesterday. He was 80, reports BSS.

Justice Islam who joined High Court Division of Bangladesh Supreme Court in 1972 and retired from Appellate Division in 1983 was buried yesterday afternoon at the Azampur Graveyard.

A native of Kushtia, Justice Islam had his Master's and LLB from Aligarh University. He served as Advocate General of erstwhile East Pakistan in 1970. He joined legal profession in 1951. He served as Chairman of Press Council for six years (1986-92).

He left behind his wife, four sons a large number of admirers to mourn his death.

The *qukhuan* of the deceased will be held in the city on Tuesday after *Asr* prayers at his 9/19 Iqbal Road residence in the city.

A UNB report adds: President Shahabuddin Ahmed visited the residence of Justice Ruhul Islam.

He stayed there for some time and consoled the members of the bereaved family.

The President observed that late Justice Ruhul Islam was a dignified man with a strong character and lived a very simple life.

President prayed for the eternal peace of the departed soul.

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina yesterday expressed her profound shock at the death of Justice Ruhul Islam, a retired judge of the Appellate Division of the Supreme Court and former Chairman of Bangladesh Press Council.

In a condolence message sent from Doha, Qatar, where she is attending the 9th OIC Summit, the prime minister expressed her sympathy to the members of the bereaved family and prayed for the peace of the departed soul.

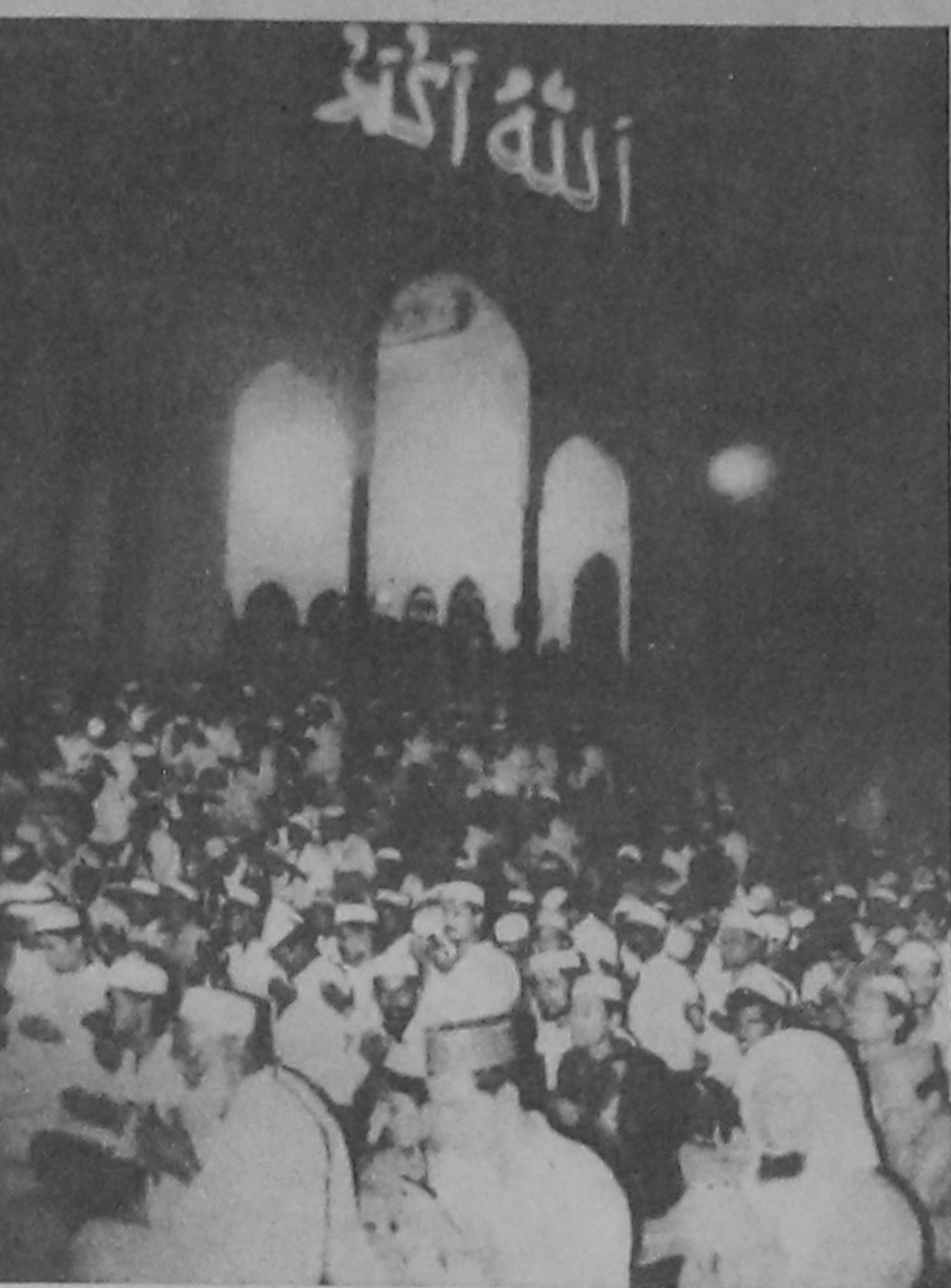

RMC students lay siege to principal's office

RAJSHAHI, Nov 12: Several hundred agitating students of Rajshahi Medical College (RMC) under the banner of All-Party Students' Action Committee (APSAC) laid a siege to the office of the principal of the college yesterday protesting transfer of two senior teachers.

They also observed a token hunger strike and submitted a memorandum to the Health Minister through the principal demanding realisation of their demands.

Prof Shamim Ahmed, Head of the Department of Nephrology and Prof Gopal Chandra Sarker, Head of the Department of Physiology were recently transferred to Barisal Medical College without any replacement.

APSAC leaders addressing during the programme said, the college has been facing shortage of teachers for long. Transfer of the two senior teachers without any replacement would further aggravate the prevailing situation.

In the memorandum, APSAC demanded immediate withdrawal of the transfer orders of the two senior teachers and filling up of all the vacant posts of teachers in the college.

APSAC, comprising Bangladesh Chhatra League, Jatityabadi Chhatra Dal, Islami Chhatra Shibir and Chhatra Union, also put up barricade on the road in front of the college gate.

Meanwhile, Rajshahi Medical College Teachers Association (RMCTA) in an emergency meeting yesterday expressed deep concern over the prevailing situation in the college over transfer orders of two senior teachers.

RMCTA going that the teachers should not be transferred without replacement.

BCU, SCF rallies at IU demand release of students

ISLAMIC UNIVERSITY, Kushtia, Nov 12: Bangladesh Chhatra Union (BCU) and Samajtantrik Chhatra Front (SCF), a left leaning student organisation, held rallies at different places in Kushtia town today demanding release of detained students.

Seventy-three students sent to jail with 42 sheet under Public Safety Act (PSA) on charge of damaging VC's residence last week. Student leaders condemned the authorities for dilly-dallies in meeting their 5-point demand in this regard. They announced to boycott examination till the release of students.

Among others Biplob Shahia (BCU), Hafiz Uddin (SCF), Mowar Hossain Tapos (BCU) and Feroz Ahmed (SCF) addressed the rally. After three-day holiday the university will reopen tomorrow. All-Party Student Action Committee will declare their future action tomorrow in this regard.

CHITTAGONG, Nov 12: Police arrested seven persons with ammunition and recovered snatched spics in two separate drives in the city today.
