

Rickshawpuller stabbed to death in city

Miscreants stabbed to death a young rickshawpuller near his house at Mirzapur in the city's Shyamnupur area early hours of yesterday.

The victim was identified as Khokon, 25, son of Noor Mohammad Ullah.

Hospital sources quoting the family members said that Khokon came out of his house

at 10 am Friday. Azharul, elder brother of the victim found him dead at about 1 am yesterday.

The reason behind the killing of the young man could not be known immediately.

The body of the victim was sent to the Mitford hospital for autopsy.

Azharul filed a case with Shyamnupur thana in this regard.
