

Tk 1.2cr for post-flood rehab in Satkhira

BAGERHAT, Nov 21: Government has sanctioned housing grant and food assistance for the flood victims of Satkhira district, reports UNB.

Sources at Satkhira Relief and Rehabilitation office said an amount of Tk 1.2 crore has been sanctioned under the housing grant from which each family will get Tk 1,000.

Meanwhile, Tk 1.09 crore has been sanctioned for the flood-ravaged Sadar, Kalaroa, Ashassuni, Tala and Devhata upazilas and two municipalities.

Besides, 1,08,673 VGF cards will be distributed among the affected people under which each affected family will get 10 kgs of rice every month.

The cards will be distributed among the people of 32 affected unions and two municipalities. Rice will be distributed till January 15 under the VGF programme, officials said.

They said huge crops, including paddy and vegetables, on 27,394 hectares of land worth of Tk 80 crore were damaged by flood here.

Meanwhile, the government has allotted 510 mts of seed of high yielding variety of boro, 127.5 mts of

wheat seed, 15 mts of corn seed, 8.75 mts of pulse seeds, 7.5 mts of mustard seed and 1.5 mts of vegetable seeds so that the farmers can recoup their crop losses.

BSS from Chuadanga reports: The Khulna Divisional Fuel Oil Distributors and Tank-Lorry Owners Association has distributed one thousand sares and one thousand litres of kerosene oil among the 1000 flood affected women of Jibannagar Upazila, Darsana Municipality of Chuadanga district and Moheshpur Upazila of Meherpur district recently.

Of the total relief materials recipients there were 300 women in Jibannagar Upazila, 200 women in Darsana Municipality, 300 women in Moheshpur Upazila and 200 women in Mujibnagar Upazila.

SM Eusuf Ali, President and M Sazzadul Karim Kabul, Secretary of the Khulna Divisional Fuel Oil Distributors and Tank-Lorry Owners Association were present there.

Each woman got one piece of saree and one litre of kerosene oil.

Problems grip Sirajganj hospital

SIRAJGANJ, Nov 21: Despite the government slogan of "Health for all by the year 2000" people here are being deprived of minimum healthcare facilities.

Poor patients are getting only paracetamol tablets from the hospital since long. Hospital sources said the government has announced upgradation of Sirajganj General Hospital from 100 bed to 250 bed, but it has not been upgraded. The hospital can not ensure better healthcare facilities to 27 lakh people. Local people said as the announcement was made without any physical facilities, the suffering of the treatment seeking people could not be minimised, rather massive irregularities by some doctors, officials and employees have multiplied it.

It was learnt that doctors and nurses often misbehave with patients and their attendants. Being the lone hospital in the district it cannot cope with the increasing number of patients and most of them are to stay on the floor of the hospital. Paucity of

water, absence of regular cleaning, shortage of medicine and pathological test facilities, negligence of the doctors made the situation worse in the hospital.

There are no facilities of EOG and ultrasonogram and the X-ray machine of the hospital remained out of order since long. A staff of the hospital on condition of anonymity said the X-ray machine was made inoperative to compel the patients to go to the private pathological laboratories of some doctors of the hospital. The lone ambulance of the hospital remained inoperative for the last three years as it could not be repaired due to shortage of fund.

Patients complained that the doctors and nurses do not take care of them. Moreover, they directly and indirectly influence them to go to their private chambers and pathological laboratories. They said the doctors are not interested to provide treatment to the patients in the hospital, rather they remain engaged in their clinics most of the time. Some patients alleged that the

contractors supply sub-standard food to them with the connivance of a section of hospital officials.

Stepmother suspected in Ajufa killing

JHENIDAH, Nov 21: Police suspect stepmother Nasima Khatun, 32, was the main culprit behind the rape and killing of Ajufa Sundari.

A gang of miscreants at Berinni village under Harinakundu upazila here on Saturday strangled Ajufa, 16, and raped her and her mother. Some locals said the stepmother stage-managed the incident to kill the disabled girl with the help of the miscreants. Father of the girl is now in jail in connection with a case.

When contacted, Nasima, who is now in Jhenidah Sadar Hospital, denied the allegation.

42 bazaars affected by flood in Chuadanga

CHUADANGA, Nov 21: The hats and bazaars in four upazilas and two municipalities of Chuadanga district are in pitiable condition.

As a result buyers and sellers suffer a lot. Lack of proper maintenance is the main reason behind poor condition of bazaars.

The hats and bazaars came into being at local initiatives in different times, but those are not expanded and developed keeping pace with time.

Not a single bazaar has proper drainage system. The situation worsens during rainy season when most of the hats and bazaars go under knee deep water. Congested places for selling fish, vegetables and other commodities and extortion of tolls by 'jaradars' have multiplied the misery of both buyers and sellers.

Absence of pure drinking water facilities in these hats and bazaars is an additional problem. All the hats and bazaars lack both latrine and urinals. Filths and garbage are piled up hither and thither emitting bad odour. As a result, public health is threatened.

Shortage of sheds is also another serious problem in these hats and bazaars. Most of the bazaars sit under open sky. A very few of those have tin shed structure. Shopping of different commodities on the adjacent roads and lanes of the bazaars is a regular feature.

It may be noted here that there are 42 hats and bazaars in this district. In the recent flood most hats and bazaars have been severely affected and a good number of those have been damaged. Under such circumstances it has become urgent to repair and properly maintain the hats and bazaars.

BCL activists go on rampage at Rajshahi Polytech Instt

RAJSHAHI, Nov 21: Activists of the ruling party backed-BCL went on the rampage in Rajshahi Polytechnic Institute on Thursday.

They ransacked furniture and damaged doors and windows. They also put the office of the Principal under lock and key.

The Bangladesh Chhatra League activists brought out a procession demanding admission quota for them, sources said.

They pulled down the notice board with a list of candidates selected for admission and threw it into a nearby pond. Later, they entered the administrative office and went on a rampage.

The principal, teachers, officials and general students left the campus.

Police rushed to the spot and brought the situation under control.

News snaps

Robbers beat cops, snatch bullets

HABIGANJ, Nov 21: Robbers snatched a magazine containing 19 rounds of bullets, after beating two police constables on Montala-Eroshpur road in Madhabpur upazila on Sunday, reports UNB.

Police said the robbers netted the constables, Abdul Hakim and Belayet, while they were patrolling near a bridge at about 8 pm. They later hit the policemen with a sharp weapon and snatched two rifles and a magazine containing bullets from them. They, however, left the two rifles before fleeing the scene. The injured policemen were admitted to Madhabpur upazila health complex.

Trawlers with clinkers seized

BAGERHAT, Nov 21: Police seized two trawlers laden with 2,000 maunds of clinkers and arrested the drivers from Shupari Patti ghat of Bhairab river on Saturday, reports UNB.

Police said Tapos Saha, the gang leader of the smuggling syndicate of the region, smuggled the clinkers from Mongla port. The contraband was seized while being stored at his godown. A case was filed in this connection.

Three with arms held

RAJBARI, Nov 21: Police arrested three young men along with firearms from Barajuri village in Sadar upazila on Sunday, reports UNB.

On information, police arrested Shamim, 20, Shahajan, 25, and Samad, 30, from the village along with two country-made rifles a sharp weapon while they were preparing for committing dacoity. Besides, police recovered a revolver and 100 bullets of phensidyl and arrested 22 people on various charges from different parts of the upazila on the same day. Separate cases were filed.

20 hurt as villagers clash

MANIKGANJ, Nov 21: A clash between two groups of people over harvesting crops at Shinguri village in Gheor upazila left at least 20 people injured on Monday, reports UNB.

Eight of the injured were identified as Shamejuddin, 35, Muksed Ali, 30, Shobhab Ali, 40, Afzal, Shahera Banu, 32, Khurshed, 16, Sohagjan, 35, and Nurul Haque. They were admitted to Sadar Hospital with serious injuries.

Training on soil fertility

NASRINGDI, Nov 21: A two-day training on 'Soil Fertility and Fertiliser Management' concluded here on Wednesday at Raipura upazila Agriculture Extension office, reports BSS.

A total of 50 block supervisors of Raipura upazila participated in the programme. Abdul Mojib Biswas, Deputy Director of Agriculture Extension Directorate, Narasingdi, Shariatul Hossain, subject matter specialists, and Abdul Khaled, Raipura upazila Agriculture Extension Officer, gave briefing to the participants.

Man gets 10-yr RI

RAJBARI, Nov 21: A court here recently sentenced a man to 10 years' rigorous imprisonment in an arms case, reports UNB.

The convict was identified as Rajab Ali of Bara Laxmipur village in Sadar upazila. According to the prosecution, police on information arrested Ali along with a country-made pipe gun from the village on May 7 this year. After examining the records and witnesses, the Judge handed down the verdict.

27,480 VGF cards distributed

PIROJPUR, Nov 21: The government has allocated 27,480 VGF cards to distribute some 1,092 mts of rice among distressed mothers and children in six upazilas of the district, reports UNB.

Officials said 4,000 VGF cards have been allocated for Nazirpur, 5,000 for Sadar, 2,500 for Kaukhali, 5,000 for Nesarabad, 3,500 for Bhandaria, 5,500 Mathbaria upazilas and 990 cards for Swarupkathi pourasava while 990 for Mathbaria pourasava. Each cardholder will get 20 kg of rice for two months: October and November.

Four killed in road accidents

RAJSHAHI, Nov 21: Four people, including a minor boy, were killed and nine others injured in two separate road accidents in Rajshahi and Naogaon on Saturday.

Three people were killed and nine others injured when a passenger bus dashed a rickshaw and some stationed vehicles beside Rajshahi-Naogaon highway in Shutihata area under Manda upazila of Naogaon district.

The dead were identified as Anisur Rahman, 35, of Enayetpur village, Sekander Ali, 38 of Durgapur village and Shahidul Islam, 26, of Govindapur village- all in Manda upazila.

Three seriously injured Jan Mohammad, 28, Habib Uddin, 30, and Shaheeb Ali, 22, were admitted to Rajshahi Medical College Hospital in critical condition. Six others were admitted to Manda Upazila Health Complex.

Police seized the bus but the driver managed to flee.

Meanwhile, in separate incident, a minor boy, Delwar Hossain Surju, was killed on the spot when a truck crushed him in Godagari Rail Gate area in Godagari upazila.

Details could not be known.

Housewife murdered in Satkhira

SATKHIRA, Nov 21: A housewife was killed and at least twenty others were injured when a gang of miscreants equipped with iron rods and sharp weapons attacked a neighbourhood, where landless people live, in Kunduria area under Assasuni upazila here on Saturday night.

The dead was identified as Farida Khatun, 20.

The residents in the area said a section of influential people are trying to evict them from the neighbourhood, established on 'khas' land. A total of forty landless families have been living in the area since 1982.

The victims said people led by UP member Nurul Islam attacked the families at 8 pm.

They also looted valuables and ransacked the house during the attack.

Trader abducted in Chittagong
