Speakers call for mass resistance against enemies of independence

Leaders of Sammilita Nagorik Samaj, a platform of the country's professional bodies and intellectuals, yesterday called for unity of pro-liberation forces to build a mass resistance against the anti-liberation elements, reports BSS.

The anti-liberation fundamental elements are hatching conspiracies against the country's sovereignty and independence to turn Bangladesh into Pakistan and they are making parody of the national anthem, they said.

The leaders were speaking at a civic rally at the Central Shaheed Minar here to protest conspiracies against the independence of the country and dishonouring of the national anthem.

They demanded banning publication of the Daily Inqilab and immediate arrest of and exemplary punishment to its owner, publisher and editor for

making parody of the national anthem.

Presided over by National Professor Kabir Chowdhury, the rally was addressed among others by Political Adviser to the Prime Minister Dr S A Malek, Vice-Chancellor of Dhaka University Prof A K Azad Chowdhury, Dr Shamsul Huda Harun, Chairman of Central Command Council of Bangladesh Mukti Joddha Front, and Prof Abdul Muktijuddin.

Dr Malek, who is also the convener of the Sammilita Mukti Joddha Front, said the pro-liberation forces including the freedom fighters would not allow them to implement their evil designs.

He called on all pro-liberation and progressive democratic forces to remain vigilant against the heinous designs of these anti-liberation quarters and build strong resistance so that they could not raise their ugly heads.

Reading out the declaration, Dr B K Zahangir demanded trial of the war criminals under a special tribunal, banning of communal politics and immediate execution of the verdict of Bangabandhu Murder Case.

Crisis in BCL deepens further

Crisis in the Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) has deepened further due to cancellation of an emergency meeting of its Dhaka University unit committee following pressure from the BCL top leaders.

The DU unit of BCL called for the meeting at 10 am on the campus following an intra-party discord over formation of a party committee at History Department on Thursday. But the top BCL leaders asked the DU unit leaders to cancel its meeting.

On Thursday last, a group of BCL men led by central leaders Selim and Lablu launched an attack on the council of the History Department unit BCL at room no 1022 of the Arts Building leaving at least five party activists injured.

The attackers also manhandled DU unit BCL general secretary A K M Azim while he was conducting a weekly meeting of the BCL unit committee at History Department on Thursday. But the top BCL leaders were compelled to cancel it on the plea to avert further trouble in the organisation.

Most of the BCL leaders and activists expressed their strong grievance for what they said interference of central leadership in the DU unit affair.

Meanwhile, today's council of Rolecya Hall unit of BCL became uncertain due to an unclear situation on the campus following this incident.

Many BCL activists suspected that Thursday's incident was a planned one masterminded by some top BCL leaders to help one of their top leaders to play behind the scene role.

When contacted, BCL president Bahadur Bepari told The Daily Star that he was going to take stern action against those responsible for the incident.

"Certainly it's a big problem for the party that has to be solved soon," Bepari said.
