

Papers presented at the seminar also said that about half of the women in the country are acutely malnourished and risk suffering from complications of pregnancies as well as delivering babies weighing less than 2,500 grams or pre-

mature delivery. It also revealed that 94 per cent of the childbirth take place at home under worst possible conditions and very few receive help from trained attendants.

Participants identified inadequate availability of preventive and promotive health care services in the field of antenatal care, poor obstetric techniques during childbirth and more significantly, lack of access to life saving procedures in emer-

They also said that the major causes of deaths are obstructed labour, eclampsia, excessive bleeding, and complications of unsafe abortion and injuries.

"There is an urgent need to inform general people that reproductive health and Emergency Obstetric Care (EOC) services are available, afford able and accessible at government institutions." Tahera Ahmed, Assistant Representative of United Nations Population Fund in Bangladesh.

Tahera also said, "Continued support is needed for Maternal and Child Welfare Centre (MCWCs) to help doctors and paramedies to provide the nec-
