'Call to work for promotion of peace'

Speakers at a meeting yesterday called upon all to work towards the promotion of brotherhood and fellow feelings among the people of various faiths and nations with a view to restoring peace in the world. They were addressing the sixth Dhaka International Meeting for World Peace under the auspices of Haqqani Anjuman Bangladesh chapter at the Jatiya Press Club auditorium. Minister for Science and Technology Lt. Gen (Rtd.) M. Nooruddin Khan said poverty alleviation, economic emancipation and reduction of discrimination between people can bring peace in the world. He urged the big powers to take initiative for establishing peace.

Maj. Gen. (Rtd.) S.M. Ibrahim, Bir Pratik, Executive Director of Centre for Strategic & Peace Studies in his speech underscored the need for holding inter-faith prayer meeting all over the world as meetings have been contributing towards the promotion of world peace. A.K. Faezul Huq, State Minister for Jute, who attended the function as special guest said if people of every religion follow their respective religions properly then peace is bound to be established on the earth. Mohammad Shahita Zerab, Ambassador of Palestine & Dean of the Diplomatic Corps

urged people of different religions to sink their differences. Terming the prevailing situation in Palestine as very volatile and difficult he called upon the people to save the Palestine from the grip of Israel. Edward Joseph Adams, the Apostolic of Nunciatore in Bangladesh said the new generation has rejected the discrimination and exploitation to establish peace and religion could play a vital role for bringing peace in the earth.

E.G. Daynanda, High Commissioner of Sri Lanka said justice and love could be two ideal instruments for peace. Presided over by Barkat Ullah Bulu, MP, the meeting was addressed among others by G.M. Quader, MP, and Mir Quasem Ali, Former Director General of Islamic Foundation and Dr. Reazul Huq, Azizul Huq, Abu Zafair Khan and Moazzem Hossain, Secretary, Haqqani Anjuman Bangladesh. Swapan Kumar Saha, General Secretary of the Jatiya Press Club represented the Hindu community. Srimat Nanda represented the Buddhist community and Father Benjamin Costa represented the Christian community in the prayer meeting attended by hundreds of devotees from different religions from home and abroad.

'Pakistan must seek apology'

Muktijuddher Chetana Bastabayan O Ekattorer Ghatak Datal Nirmul Committee yesterday demanded that Pakistan must seek apology formally for making audacious comments against the independence of Bangladesh by its Deputy High Commissioner in Dhaka, reports UNB.

"We will treat Pakistan as an enemy state until it tries the war criminals, return Bangladesh's wealth and repatriate its stranded citizens after seeking apology," said a resolution adopted in an extended meeting of the steering committee.

The meeting strongly condemned the comments made by deputy High Commissioner Erfan-ur Rahman Raza while speaking at a discussion in the capital on Monday.

The meeting said top leaders of four-party opposition alliance, including Begum Khaleida Zia, did not lodge and protest against the arrogant comments made by the Pakistani envoy. The committee leaders urged the freedom fighters in four-party opposition alliance as well as the countrymen to take strong stance against the conspiracy being hatched by local collaborators.

Water Resources Minister Abdur Razzak, Fisheries and Livestock Minister ASM Abdur Rab, State Minister for Shipping Molazzal Hossain Chowdhury, Maya, member secretary Prof Abdul Mannan Chowdhury, Muktijuddha Sangsad Chairman Principal Ahad Chowdhury were, among others, present in the meeting.

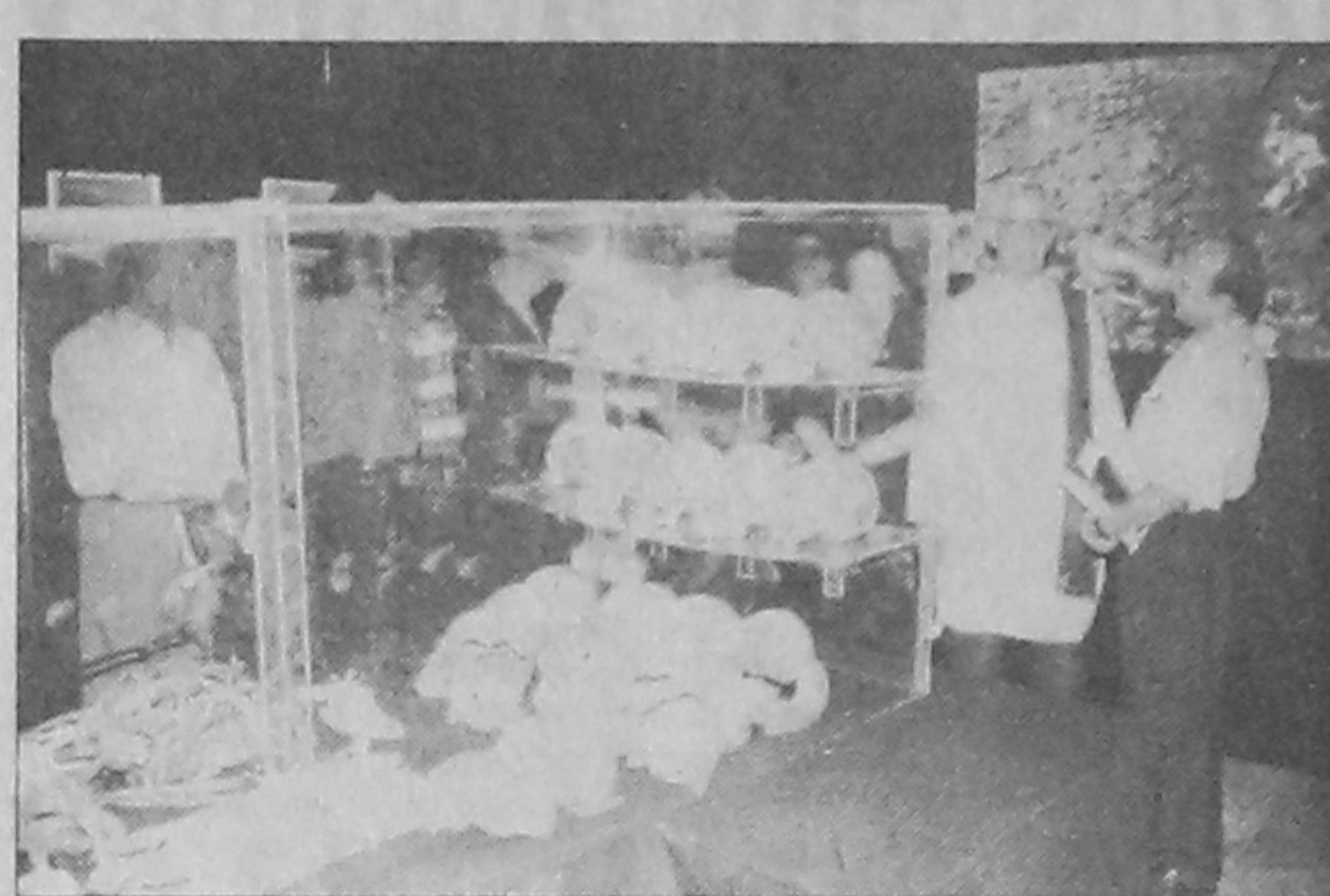

Around 100 killing fields detected across the country

Month-long exhibition begins at Liberation War Museum

Liberation War Museum has detected around one hundred killing fields of 1971 across the country since the excavation of two killing fields in the city's Mirpur area last year. convenor of the War Crimes Facts Finding Committee M A Hasan said. The museum will resume its excavation programme immediately after it gets order from the court, said M A Hasan yesterday during the inauguration of month-long exhibition titled "Gaurabmoy Attadan Chiragarak glorious supreme sacrifice of the martyrs will be ever remembered".

The launching ceremony of the museum's first publication "Ekattur: Gaurabmoy Attadan Chiragarak glorious supreme sacrifice of the martyrs will be ever remembered" was also held. Book contains evidence of genocide committed by Pakistani occupation army and their collaborators during War of Liberation in 1971. Besides, rare photographs and video-clippings of archival value, the Museum authority is also exhibiting 75 skulls and 5900 various human bones exhumed from two killing grounds of Mirpur last year. The exhibition as well as the publication ceremony was attended, among others, by US Ambassador Mary Ann Peters, Reverend Richard William Tun and Prof Anisuzzaman.

Director of the Liberation War Museum Akku Chowdhury delivered a welcome address while Reverend Timi launched the book. "The Liberation War Museum has been set up to collect and disseminate information regarding our Liberation War. In this process we have involved ourselves in finding and projecting the true picture of our liberation struggle and seek justice for those millions of martyrs who were perished in the most inhuman way," said Akku Chowdhury.

Reverend Richard William Tun recalled how he came in touch with eight Hindu sweepers of Dhaka Cantonment in 1971 who told him that each of them got 80 Takas from Pak Army every day for burying dead bodies. The rate was only 25 paise for burying each dead body.

A number of foreigners as well as people from all walks of life attended the ceremony. Elaine Unerhall, Professor of Sociology of Education from UK said, "I'm really shocked at the revelation of such atrocities. I had no idea earlier."

Like Elaine, Faveja Akhter from Ruggam, mother of martyr Shahidullah also attended the programme wearing burkha. Shahidullah was her eldest son who did not return from the war front. There are thousands of bones and skulls recorded, who knows one of these could be her son's.
