Metropolitan**Nikunja murder****21st prosecution witness cross-examined**

Sub-inspector Abdul Alim Sarker, the first investigation officer of the sensational Nikunja Bihari Debnath Murder Case was cross-examined in the Fifth Additional Metropolitan Sessions Judge's Court, Dhaka on Thursday.

Judge Syed Anisul Islam adjourned the proceedings of the case till January 7.

Alim, also the 21st prosecution witness in the case, told the court that he investigated the case till January 15. Later, the case was transferred to CID for final investigation and senior ASP Abdul Kahar Akand was appointed as the second investigation officer, he added.

Earlier, 20 prosecution witnesses including the complainant of the case were cross-examined.

All the seven accused - Shukur Ali, Rana Deen Islam, Shahinur, Mojibur, Mahinur and Morshed - were produced in the court during the proceedings.

Nikunja Bihari Debnath, 55, Joint-Secretary of the Ministry of Local Government and Rural Development, was stabbed to death by muggers near the Swadhinata Sangram Sculpture on the Dhaka University Campus on January 11, this year.

Nirupam Debnath, son of the victim, filed a murder case with Ramna thana the same day.

The investigation officers submitted a chargesheet to the CMM's Court Dhaka, against the accused on February 22.

The court framed charges against the accused on July 9.

Assistant PP S M Rafiqul Islam appeared for the state while Advocate Shahana for the accused.

JU unit of BCL burns Inquilab

Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) Jahangirnagar University unit Thursday night burnt about 11000 copies of the Daily Inquilab near the university campus as part of its country-wide protest and condemnations against the daily, reports BSS.

Earlier, they also burnt effigies of Maolana Mannan and on Bahauddin Ahmed - owner and the editor of the Inquilab on the campus and vowed to resist the transportation of the daily on the Dhaka-Aracha highway.

Triple murder**17 PBCP men****acquitted of charges in Khulna**

KHULNA, Dec 1: Gazi Kamrul of Purbo Banglar Communist party and 16 others of the same outlawed party have been acquitted of charges in the triple murder case.

The judgement was delivered on Wednesday afternoon by Hasan Imam, Additional District and Sessions Judge.

According to prosecution story, three armed cadres of PBCP-Tiger Khokon, Endad and Hanif were shot dead by the accused at midnight on November 28, 1997 in a house at Diarhia village under Digholia thana of Khulna district.

The murders were a sequel to intra-party feud over arms deal and financial matters.

The triple murder case was later transferred to CID. CID submitted chargesheet against 17 out of 26 accused named in the FIR, 21 persons deposed in the court.

The chargesheeted accused were acquitted due to lack of evidence against them.

The acquitted also include Shaheen Das, ring leader of Dumarua based unit of outlawed PBCP who along with Gazi Kamrul surrendered to police under general amnesty last year.

Gazi Kamrul and Shaheen Das were also acquitted by the court on Wednesday in Jamuni murder case of Daulatpur thana.

'Bangladesh's literacy rate to reach 64 pc by year-end'

Education Minister ASHK Sadique has said the literacy rate of Bangladesh will reach 64 per cent by the end of the year, according to a message received here, reports BSS.

The literacy rate of the country has increased to 62 per cent due to strong commitments of the present government," he said while responding on behalf of the participating ministers of Commonwealth countries to the keynote speech of Janet K Museveni, First Lady of Uganda.

The 14th conference of Commonwealth Education Ministers, held in Halifax in Canada from November 27-30.

Giving a brief account of development in the education sector of the country in recent years, the minister reiterated Bangladesh's commitment to

ward literacy, universal primary education, gender parity in education and poverty eradication.

Referring to the introduction of female students' stipend programme in Bangladesh he said that the programme had proved successful and as a result of enrolment of female students increased and dropout rate has come down significantly.

This has far reaching impact on women empowerment and a balanced economic development, he added.

He reiterated the importance of higher and technical education and impressed upon the Commonwealth member countries, particularly technologically advanced countries to come forward in helping the developing countries to reduce the gap amongst the member

countries.

In respect to Bangladesh's commitment towards technical and higher education, he referred to establishment of 12 science and technology universities in the country and sought cooperation of the developed countries for imparting training to the teachers and equipment supply for these universities.

In reply to a question, he explained the position of Bangladesh delegation on different issues deliberated in minister's conference.

Delegates from 46 Commonwealth member countries, UN agencies and international organizations attended the conference.

A five-member delegation from Bangladesh headed by the Minister of Education ASHK Sadique attended the conference.

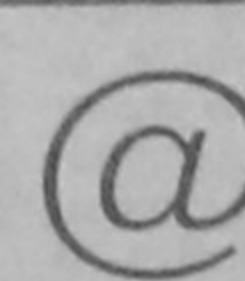
