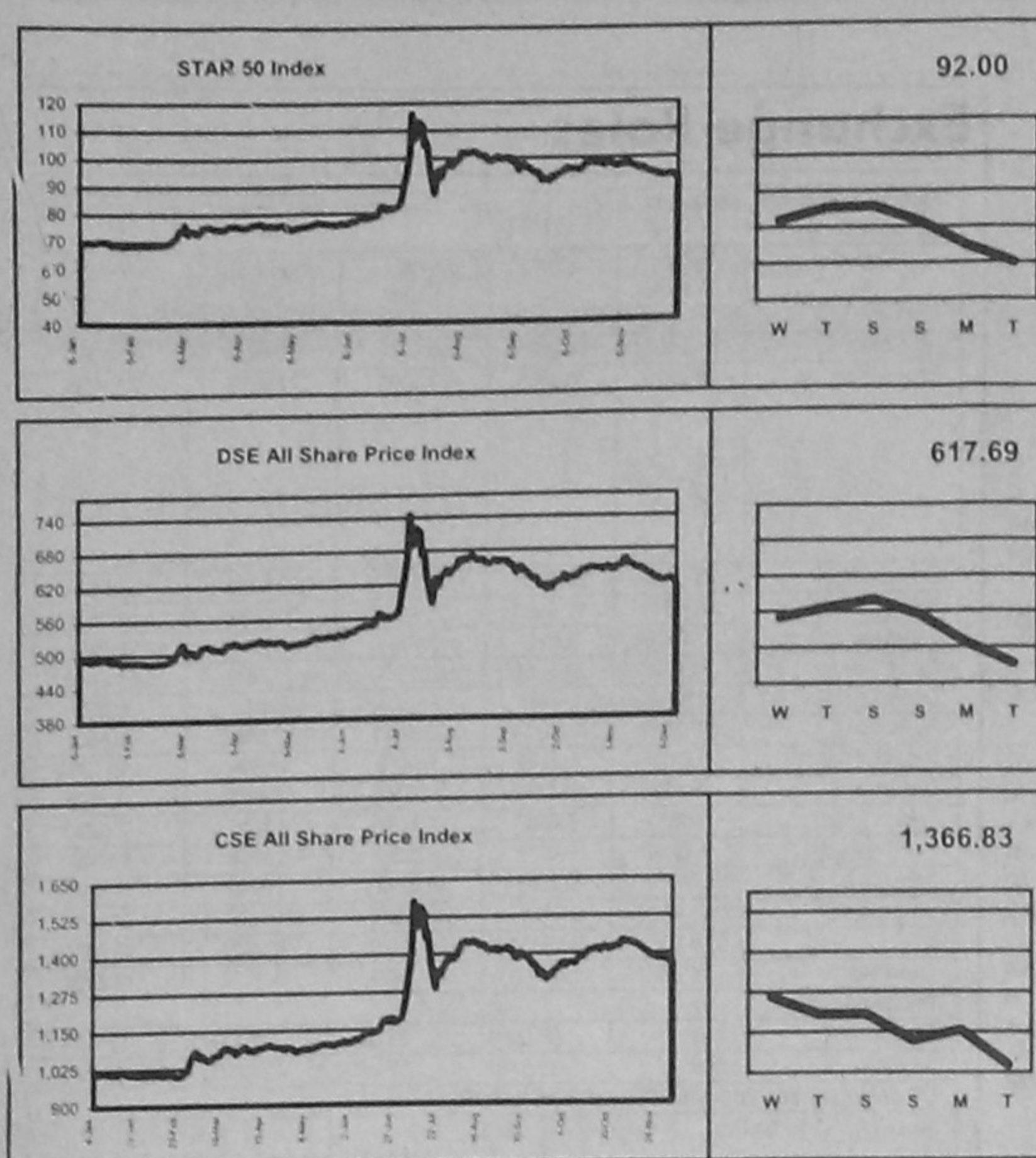

Gateway

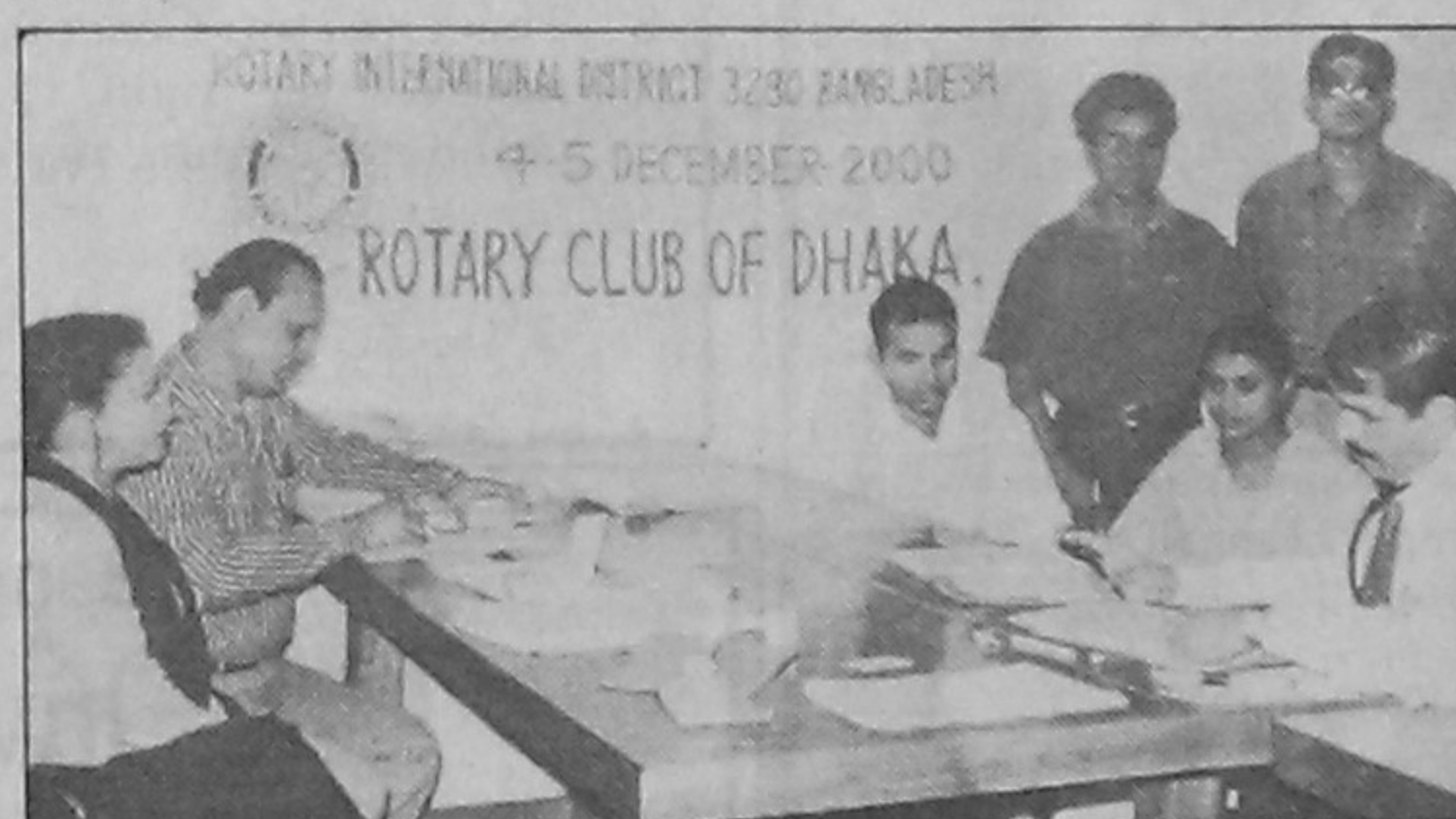
Gateway Kids' School of Computing and the Gateway Centre for Information Technology celebrated its first anniversary recently, says a press release.

DU-Rokeya-Hall students hold rally protesting rape incidents

A section of students of Rokeya Hall of the Dhaka University yesterday brought out a procession on the university campus protesting the alleged rape incidents of a female train passenger bound for Mymensingh on Saturday night and another incident at Comilla Victoria College boarding house.

Following the procession, the residents of the female dormitory held a rally at the Aparajee Bangla. Addressing the rally, the speakers said recurrence of such incidents proved the weaknesses of administration in handling the country's deteriorating law and order situation and the criminals are taking advantage of that situation in committing such crimes.

They demanded immediate arrest and exemplary punishment to those involved in the rape incidents.

Among others, Jahan-e-Gulshan, Shaupa and Taslima Miji addressed the rally.

They also brought out a procession on the hall premises on Monday night.

Biman to procure 4 aircraft soon

Biman Bangladesh Airlines will procure four wide-bodied aircraft soon to facilitate transport of passengers maintaining its flight schedule to cope with the increasing loads, reports UNB.

This will bring a qualitative change in the flight schedule of Biman. Civil Aviation Minister Engineer Mosharraf Hossain told a delegation of Travel Agents at his office yesterday.

Dr HBM Iqbal MP, president of the Association of Travel Agents of Bangladesh (ATAB), led the delegation during the meeting held in the ministry conference room.

ATAB leaders informed the minister that so far a total of Tk 1.40 crore had been paid to Bangladesh Biman as bank guarantee of travel agents.

The ATAB team requested the minister to temporarily cancel the licences of the travel agents which are not paying the bank guarantee money within the stipulated time.
