Engineer M. Abu Taher will inaugurate the festival with a day-long workshop on sun. Three topics on plasma physics, sun in the old ages and social reforms will be discussed at the workshop. An exhibition on video footage on Sun, posters and photographs will be held. A quiz competition will also be organised on the occasion.
