Solicitation for Tropical Forestry Conservation  
Fund Board Membership

The Governments of Bangladesh and the United have jointly established a Tropical Forest Conservation Fund (TFCF), with the objective of protecting a viable representative population of Bangladesh's remaining Tropical Forest Biodiversity. The fund will support activities that result in the protection of Tropical Forests and Tropical Forest Biodiversity, through the award of strategic grants to coalitions of non-government groups. The TFCF will be governed by a board consisting of five members: One each appointed by the US and Bangladesh governments, and three representatives from a broad range of nongovernmental forest/conservation-related interests within Bangladesh, including representatives from:

- Environmental nongovernmental organizations;
- Local community development nongovernmental organizations;
- Scientific, academic and/or forestry organizations.

The NGO shall be appointed to the Board by the Government of Bangladesh in consultation with a range of domestic nongovernmental entities, and with the consent of the US Government. Board members shall serve *ad honorem* and at the discretion of the appointing Party for a term of three years. Board members will serve in their expert capacity, and not as the representative of any particular group or institution.

Nominations for Board membership may be submitted by associations of NGOs, or by individual NGOs. In addition, interested individuals having a recognized association with these NGOs (e.g., serving on the Advisory Board/Steering Committee/Trustee, or associated as an Employee/Fellow/Consultant), believing they possess the requisite professional and community or forestry association-related experience, may propose themselves.

## Criteria for Board Selection

Board members should have a demonstrated commitment to forest biodiversity conservation, with interests, knowledge, and experience related to conservation of biodiversity and tropical forests, and a capacity for leadership in this field. They should be recognized by peers and colleagues within their respective communities as "bridge-builders" of national standing.

## 1. Qualifying NGO Qualifications

- Type of NGO. Environmental or Community Development.
- Years of association. Minimum five years.
- Certification. The institution should be registered with the NGO Bureau or otherwise officially registered.
- Other. The NGO or the concerned individual must be widely known for work in the areas of: environment, sustainable forestry, community development or related work. Additionally the group should be known for its membership, participation and contribution to national and international forums.

## 2. Qualifying Academic/Scientific Institution Qualifications

- Institution has a school of forestry, the environment or a related field.
- Conducts research or field studies in the area of sustainable forestry or other fields related to tropical forestry biodiversity conservation.
- Certification. The institution is nationally or internationally certified.

## 3. Minimum Individual Qualifications

- Education: BA/BSc (Honours) from a recognized institute of higher learning.
- Language: Fluent in Bangla and English.
- Work Experience: Minimum fifteen years work experience in the concerned field that demonstrates a commitment to forest and forest biodiversity conservation in Bangladesh.
- Proven effective board experience as demonstrated through membership and accomplishments on previous boards or similar organizations.

## 4. Desired Additional Qualifications

- Demonstrated abilities in senior management areas such as strategic planning, modern financial management, adaptive management, objectives achievement, staff evaluation and motivation, grant proposal review, and grant evaluation.
- Demonstrated organizational development skills such as fund raising, priority setting, managing organizational growth, advanced information management, and donor proposal development and review.
- Proven skills in public presentation, meeting management, coordination and liaison skills, and conflict management.
- Reputation for public spiritedness, honesty in financial and personal spheres, strategic mindset, fairness in decision-making based in facts, non-partisan in matters related to conservation priorities, and commitment to problem solving.
- Computer literacy (ability to use a computer for preparing documents, receiving and sending email, etc.)

## TFCF Board Selection

A committee that will include representatives of both governments will review the nominations. The committee will recommend appointments to the Govt. of Bangladesh, which will take appropriate action. The results of the selection process will be announced publicly in the various media. Decisions resulting from this process shall be final.

Interested individuals and organizations that meet the above criteria are requested to submit expressions of interest to the following box number.
