Jibannagar Bailey Bridge needs to be repaired

CHUADANGA, Nov 19: Jibannagar Bailey Bridge, an important bridge along Chuadanga-Jessore via Darsana-Kaliganj route has been badly affected by the recent flood. It is now in a pitiable condition.

Roads and Highways Department has stopped movement of all kinds of vehicles live bus, minibus, truck, lorry and oil carrier over the bridge since last Septem-The bridge needs immediate

repair. The bridge is the only getway over five lakh people of Jibannagar upazila of Chuadanga district and Kaliganj, Kotchandpur and Moheshpur upazilas of Jhenidah district.

Chuadanga district headquarters is 30 kilometres off from Jibannagar upazila sadar. The bridge is situated over the River Bhairab. Jibannagar upazila consists of four unions and one

Other two unious like Banka and Shimanto and Jibannagar are on the south of the River Bhairab. People of Jibannagar Municipality, Banka union and Shimanto union have to come to Chuadanga district headquarters everyday for various purposes crossing Jibannagar Bailey Bridge. People of Uthali and Andulbaria unious have to go to Jibannagar upazila headquarters and Kotchandpur, Kaliganj and Moheshpur under Jhenidah district by crossing the River Bhairab everyday over this bridge. Before imposing ban on movement of vehicles along the bridge over 2,000 heavy vehicles used to cross it.

These vehicles used to carry goods from Chuadanga to Kaliganj, Jessore and Khulna and from Khulna to Chuadanga and Meherpur.

To a great extent blame of traffic jam can be attributed to the Telephone Department and Comilla Municipality. Telephone Department's earth digging work in the name of commissioning cable persists over the years. Comilla Municipality under its drainage development programme has caused immense sufferings to the people.

FP staffers in misery

COMILLA, Nov 19: Nonpayment of salaries for more than five months has made the lives of over 4,000 officers and employees of Family Planning Department miserable, reports UNB.

Official sources said the salaries of 4, 199 officials and employees of the department remained unpaid since June this year due to lack of budgetary allocation. The government placed the services of the officers and employees of 'Consumer Service Project' of the department under revenue upon completion of the project and the posts were approved on October 23 this year. Some of the officers and employees have already taken loan from their provident funds to meet their day-to-day expenses. Of them, 19 are medical officers, 45 senior family planning inspectors, 23 subassistant community medical officers, 480 FWVs, 44 LDA-cumtypists, 431 family planning inspectors, two drivers, 2,280 family planning assistant, security guards and MLSS 76 and 303 maids.

Sugar mills go into production

JOYPURHAT, Nov 19: Carrying a burden of Tk 40 crore loan, Joypurhat Sugar Mills went into production on Friday with a target to produce 10,914 mts of sugar in the current crushing season, reports UNB.

Some 12,600 acres of land have been brought under sugarcane cultivation with a production target of 2.52 lakh mts of sugarcane this year. The mill sources said some 1.40 lakh metric tons of sugarcane would be crushed in the mills to produce the sugar with a recovery percentage of 7.75. However, the remaining sugarcane will be used in preparing seeds, gur and for chewing purpose. Last year, the sugar mills incurred a loss of Tk 10 crore rising the total loss to Tk 55 crore.

Later, in a views-exchange meeting with the journalists, the employees of the institute apprised the availability of necessary logistics for turning the institute into a university.

House-building loan for poor

MADARIPUR, Nov 19: The government has taken up a housebuilding loan programme for the poor in six upazilas of three southern districts, reports UNB.

The upazilas are Rajoir of Madaripur, Agailjhara, Gournadi, Banaripara and Uzirpur of Barisal and Kotalipara in Gopalganj districts. Bangladesh Development Society (BDS), a national NGO has been given the responsibility to run the loan programme. BDS sources said some 75 families with the loan money have already built their houses in Agailjhara. In the second phase some 25 more families are being brought under the programme. Besides, loan money has recently been distributed among some 368 families of Gournadi, Banaripara, Rajoir and Kotalipara upazilas. Each family is receiving a loan of Tk 20,000 in three installments to construct 220-sqft tin-shed houses on their own lands. However, the landless people were not included in the programme.
